Thomas Julius Dupont died on March 14th. 1849 at Mr. Lee's School in Asheville, N.C. He was born in 1832 and was 17 years of age. He died of congestion after an illness of only 24 hours, and was buried in the Family Cemetery on his father's plantation called Hap-Hazard, where his ancestors were buried.
