Dear Rev. Peoples,

I enjoyed hearing from you again. Yes, I heard that Dr. Miles had passed away; and I know he will be missed a great deal - I've always heard so many nice things about him. If there were more people like him, the world would surely be a better place.

I'm enclosing a sheet showing how I descend from the Girardeau family. The only information I have on Peter Girardeau is what I have on the sheet. There is one person I know who may have additional information on Peter's descendants; <sup>HE</sup> is Rev. Charles <sup>E.</sup> ~~Ronald~~ Raynal, Fort Hill Presbyterian Church, Clemson, S. C. 29631. His father did a great deal of work in gathering data on the Girardeau family - I'm sure he will be able to help you (I got all my information from him.) He is descended from the Girardeaus through William, the son of Isaac and Ann (Elliott) Girardeau.

On checking my notes again, I find that Claudia H. Freer's mother was Margaret Hyrne or Hearne from James Island--I don't know which spelling is correct; but I will certainly check on it. I know she married Edward Freer on Feb. 27, 1787; and her dates were 1772-1824. Edward Freer was the son of Solomon and Elizabeth (Hext) Freer. If the name is spelled Hearne, it will be an entirely different family, right?

I have in my possession an old ledger type book written in 1877 and brought up to 1891 by Daniel J. Wilkinson - it contains the descendants of the Wilkinson family from about 1740. The only sad thing is it contains no dates at all. I have located the Rhodes family that you mentioned; and I will certainly write to Mrs. Dawson.

Not long ago, I was looking through a S. C. Historical and Genealogical Magazine (Vol. XX, No. 1 - Jan. 1919) (by now you must know what a horrible typist I am!) any way, I saw an article on Archdale Hall mentioning an Elizabeth Elliott who married Richard Bohun Baker--was wondering if she was related to Ann Elliott, who married Isaac Girardeau. It was a most interesting account of the Baker family--I

imagine that you have read it, if not , it can be found on pages 23-27.

Wish I had more information on Peter Girardeau for you; but am sure Rev. Raynal will have something. Thank you again for the good help!

I do thank you for all the information you sent. It was a grand help; ~~and~~ I certainly do appreciate your kindness in helping me. I'll be sure to let you know what I find out.

My mother knows Leila Miles well. Her grandfather and my great-grand mother were brother and sister. I won't write to her now; but I will certainly keep her in mind.

You mentioned having a connection with the family of Edward Wilkinson. He was the brother of Col. Morton Wilkinson, who married Susannah Smith. I have some information on the Wilkinson family if you would like it for your records. I am enclosing a sheet showing how I am descended from Edward Wilkinson.

I was interested to hear that you have a McKoy line; and I was wondering if it was the same line as my husband's (I'm working on his line too) His first American ancestor was John McKay, who came over from England and settled near Wilmington, N. C. in 1749. He was born in Scotland around 1716. He was taken prisoner after the battle of Culloden by the English in 1746, and taken to the Tower of London, where he was offered his freedom if he would settle with other clansmen in N. C. He married Jane ? , and there is a record of one child; Alexander, who changed the spelling of his surname to McKoy. My husband is descended from Alexander's son, Dr. William McKoy (1782-1858).
