

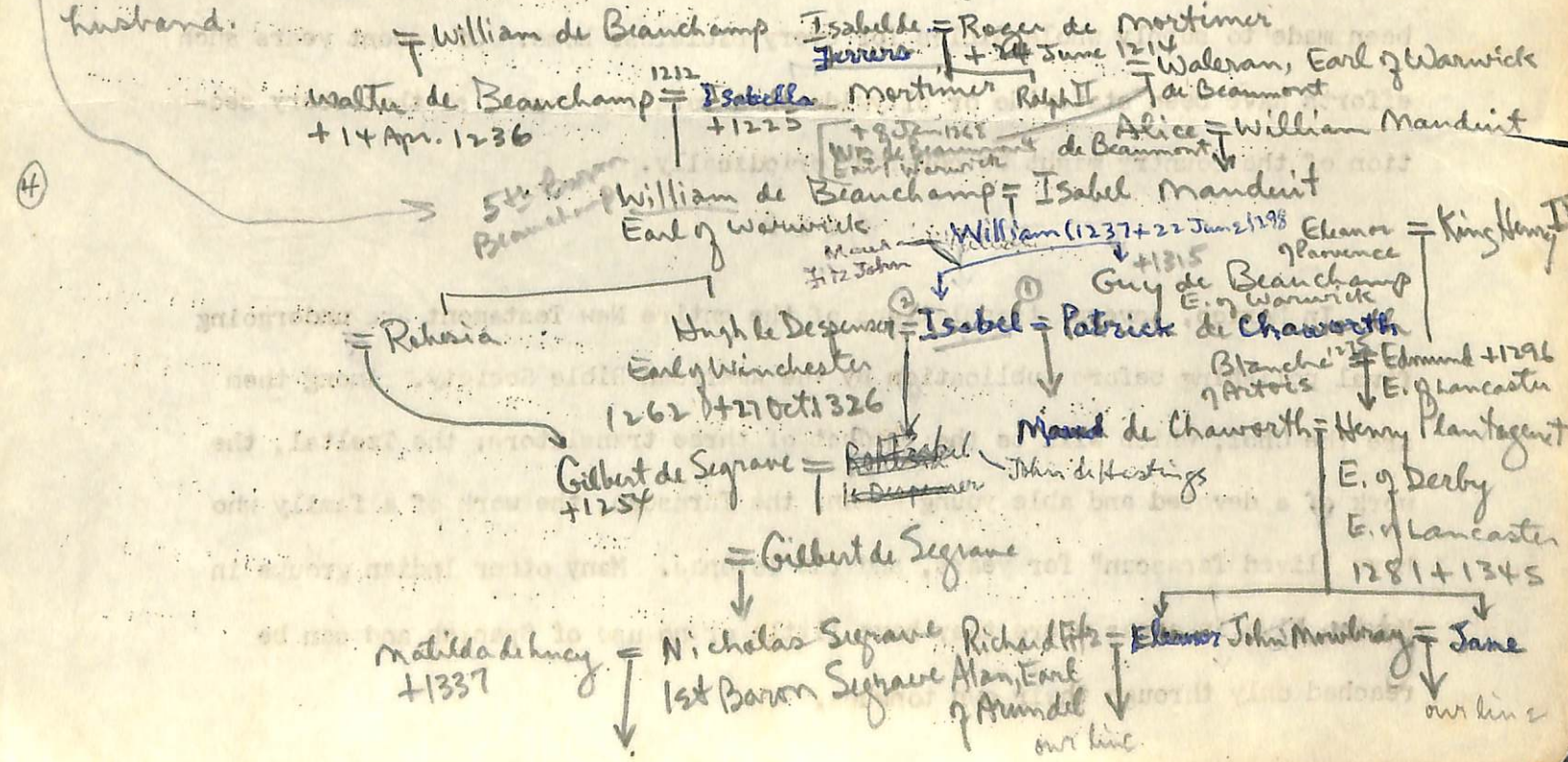
Beauchamp

Beauchamp - Mauduit - Chaworth -
Aumardel - Mowbray

- ① William de Beauchamp, Lord of Elmley, Worcester, hereditary castellan of Worcester and Sheriff of the county.
- ② Walter de Beauchamp, a minor at his father's death, obtained his shrievalty in Feb. 1216 and declared for Louis of France on his arrival in England in May 1216. His lands were seized by the Marchers and the legate excommunicated him at Whitunside. He made his peace on the accession of Henry & was a witness to his reissue of the charter on 11 Nov. 1216, being restored to his shrievalty and castellanhip. He also attested Henry's "Third Charter" on 11 Feb. 1225. In May 1226 and Jan. 1227 he was appointed an itinerant justice, & died 14 April 1236, leaving by his wife (a ^{Joan} dan. of his guardian, Roger de Mortimer) whom he married in 1212 and who died in 1225, a son & heir, William.

③ William de Beauchamp, ^{5th Baron Beauchamp} married Isabella Mauduit, dan. of William Mauduit of Hanslope, great-grandson of William Mauduit, Chamberlain of Henry I. Her mother was Alice, dan. of Waleran, earl of Warwick, from whom she inherited on the death of her brother, William, earl of Warwick (+ 8 Jan. 1268) the earldom of Warwick. Their

son, Guy de Beauchamp, earl of Warwick, died 1315. Their daughter, Isabel, married ^{① Patrick de Chaworth; dan. mand de Chaworth in Henry of Lancaster} Hugh le Despenser, earl of Winchester, as her 2nd husband.

William Manduit of Hanslope (+1257) who fought in the barons war against King John, during which his castle of Hanslope was taken + destroyed by

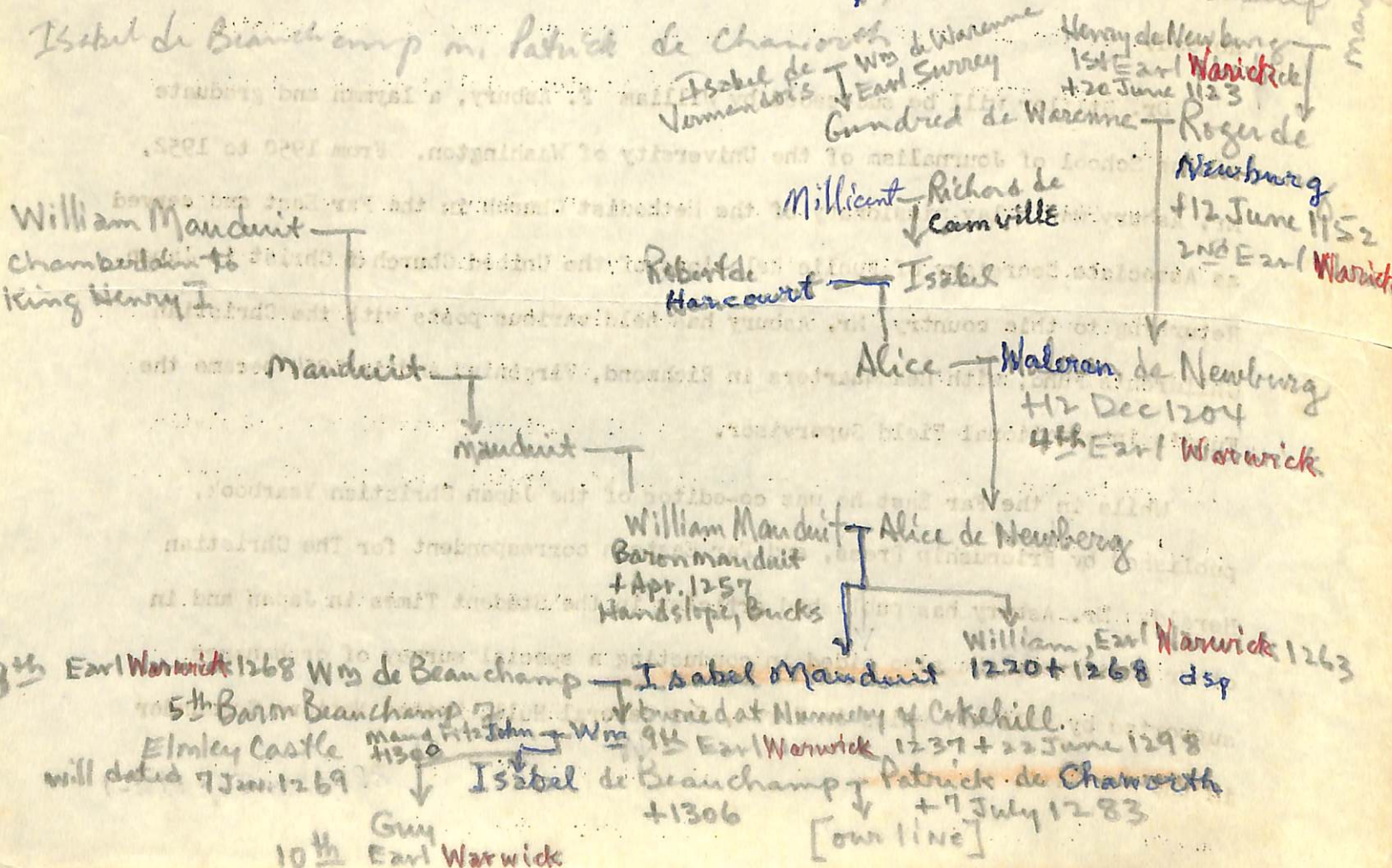
Fawkes de Breauté on 28 Nov. 1215. He fought at Lincoln on 20 May 1217. In 1233 he had to give his son as a hostage to the king but was taken into favour the following year. He died in April 1257, leaving by his wife,

Alice, dan. of Waleram, earl of Warwick, one son, William, and a daughter, Isabella. William (1220-1258) was 36 at his father's death. On the death of John de Plessis (Plessis) second husband of his cousin, Margaret de Newburg, countess of Warwick, on 4 April 1263, he became

Earl of Warwick in right of his mother. He died 8 Jan 1268 having married Alice dan. of Gilbert de Segrave, but leaving no children, the earldom of Warwick went to his sister's husband, William de Beauchamp, father of Guy de Beauchamp.

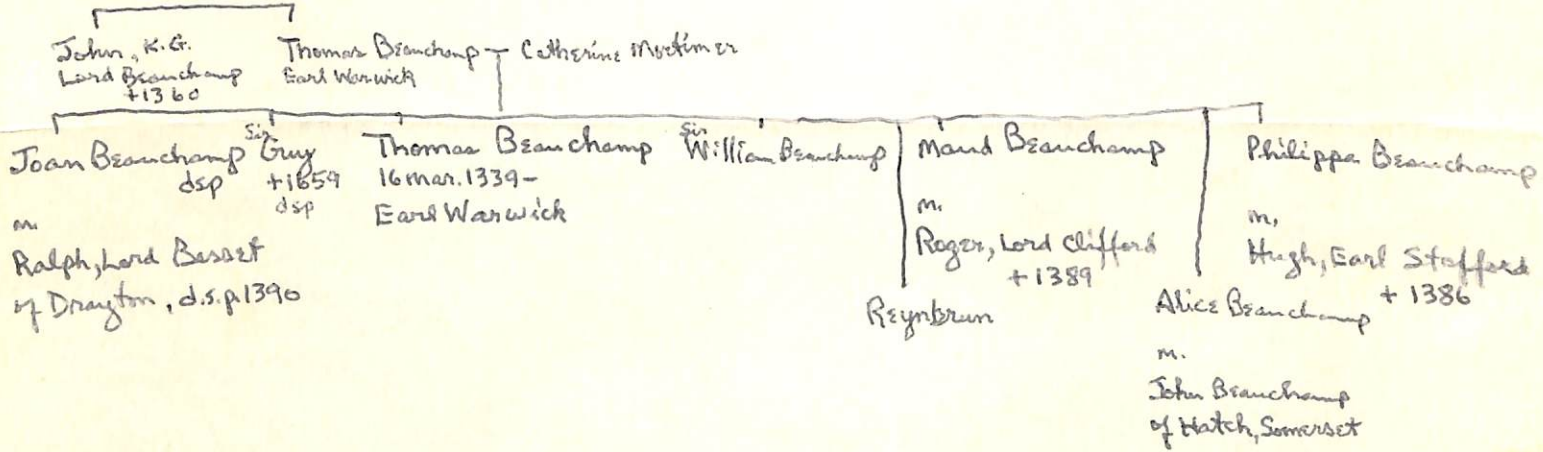
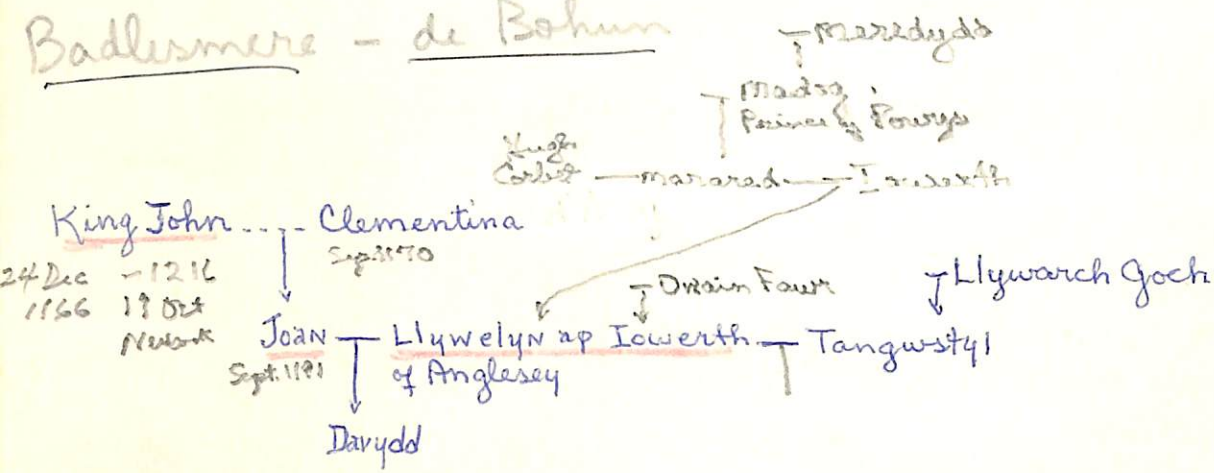
