

Howard

Sir Robert Howard m. Margaret, dau. of Thomas Mowbray, ^{1st} Duke of Norfolk (d. 1399)

Their son: John Howard, born c. 1421, present at Battle of Chastillon 17 July 1453.

Elected Knight of the shire of Norfolk 1455, knighted by Henry IV in 1461 + appointed Constable of Calchester Castle + Sheriff of Norfolk + Suffolk. In 1462 he was appointed Constable of Norwich Castle + received grants of several manors forfeited by the Earl of Wiltshire. On 3 Nov. 1465 his ^{1st} wife, Catherine, dau. of William, Lord Moleyns, died at his house at ^{Tendring Hall} Stoke, Nayland, Suffolk. In

January 1467 he married Margaret, dau. of Sir John Chedworth + in April was elected Knight of the shire of Norfolk. Although a member of the commons he was styled Lord Howard + in Nov. was appointed envoy to France and also made treasurer of the royal household, holding that until 1474. Henry VI created

him "Baron de Howard" 15 Oct. 1470. Nevertheless he proclaimed Edward King in Suffolk in March 1471 and was appointed deputy governor of Calais. He accompanied

Edward on his invasion of France in July 1475. At the funeral of Ed. IV in April 1483 he was styled "king's bannerer". Richard of Gloucester appointed him High Steward of the duchy of Lancaster on 13 May + a privy councillor.

on 28 June 1483 he was created Duke of Norfolk + Earl Marshall, reviving the dignities of the Mowbrays + Thomas of Brotherton, son of Ed. I. He was High Steward at the coronation of Richard III on 6 July, bore the crown and as marshall rode into Westminster Hall. He was appointed Admiral of England, Ireland + Aquitaine. He was slain in battle on 22 Aug. 1485 at Bosworth

+ buried in the conventual Church of Thetford - ~~always~~ faithful to the death to the House of York. He left one son + 4 dau. by his 1st wife and by his 2nd wife, Margaret, a dau. Catherine Howard who married John Bouchier, 2nd Lord Berners.

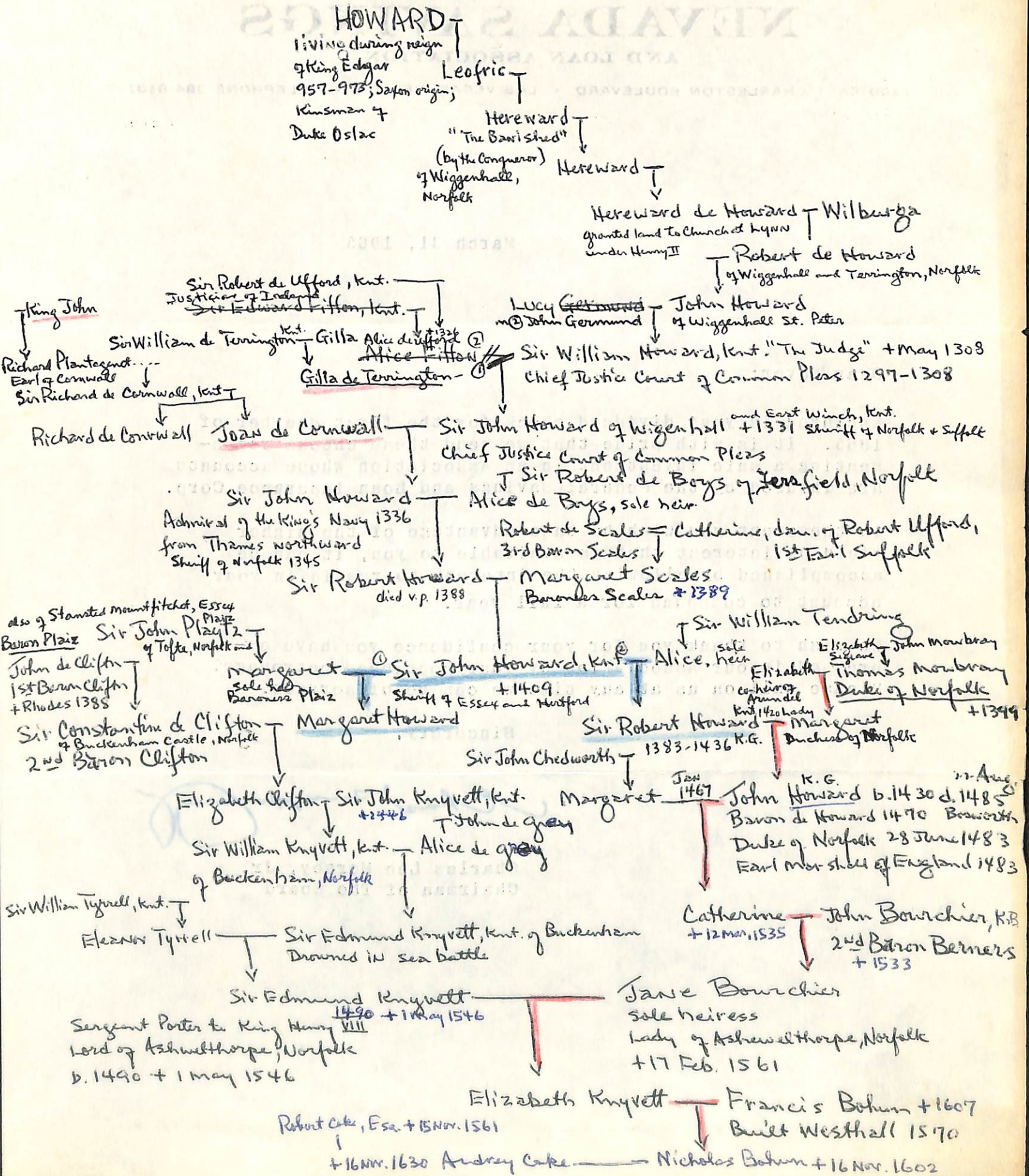
