exchange information with you. My father, John Brun-  
son, son of Joseph, departed Dorchester with wife Mary  
about 1723.

They settled on about the line of present Williams-  
burg and Berkeley Counties, and were members of Prince  
Frederick's Parish Church. Their first child, Abigail,  
was born baptized (1723) and married in the  
church of that parish. (To Stephen Peak of Prince Georges)

My first question is as to the last name of John  
Brunson's wife, Mary. It might have been either  
Way or Branford. My second is, have you any  
data on these Peaks? I cannot go back further than  
Stephen, in Prince Georges, and his sister, Mary,  
wife of John Linegood of St. Philip's Charleston.

ceived. Also I will answer back of your questions  
as I can.
