James Higginbotham & Co., and other creditors of the late Thomas M. Cater late of Barnwell District, in their petition, say that he, Cater, "was formerly of St. Peters Parish but some four or five years previously established himself in Barnwell District where he purchased a plantation and brought with him a number of negroes representing them as his own and by those means established a credit with plaintiffs. Cater died testate (blank date); Richard Johnson and (name torn off and lost) were named executors. Petitioners say that James E. McPherson has lately filed his petition in this court against Johnson stating that Cater married a Miss

Postell and that the slaves he had were subject to be recovered by him in order to make partition of the Postell Estate.

McPherson in his answer says his testatrix, Mrs. Sarah Postell, devised her estate to her two daughters (unnamed in the answer) one of whom later married said Cater; that both Cater and wife were underage when they married and that he was to execute a marriage settlement or contract for her inheritance, etc.

In the file is an original letter from Thomas Miles Cater dated August 28, 1815, addressed "my dear Friend" (addressee not named) and referring to his marriage to "your amiable daughter" and going into details as to the marriage settlement and offering to make such instruments as will be acceptable to the addressee; refers to his affairs as having been "very intricate and unpleasant" but "I have settled and passed receipts with the above named gentleman" (Col. McPherson).

Also, in the file is an original paper signed by Cater dated May 27, 1805, acknowledging to have received from James McPherson, Executor of Mrs. Sarah Postell, and Guardian for her daughter Sarah McPherson Postell now the wife of said Cater, thirty-three slaves as listed; recorded in "Marriage Settlement Book #8" page 24, April 1819, office of the Secretary of State of South Carolina.

Among the bills in the file are two by Mrs. Catherine Cater, one for administering medicine and making clothes for the slaves for four or five years, and another for board for the children of Thomas Miles Cater, viz: for Edwin Cater's board Feb. 1, 1819 to Feb. 1, 1822, @ \$80/00 per year, and for John and Andrew Cater's board in 1819 and at other times; and in a memorandum she says "nobody can deny I have acted a mother's part by these children; and it is well known that I am left destitute and have three infant children to support." Another bill was by S. R. Cannon for board of John and Richard, two sons of Thomas Miles Cater, for three months. "Court of Equity Records of Barnwell District, S. C. John J. Cater and Elizabeth Johnson, Admrs. vs. G. O. Riley, Sheriff, et al. Injunction and Distribution etc. Filed March 1, 1841.

Richard Johnson of Barnwell District, died intestate Oct. 1838, leaving as his heirs his wife the said Elizabeth and the following children: (Note: Immediately after these last four words in the petition, follows another sentence, so that no names of the children appear anywhere in the petition. However, in the answer in the file of William S. Johnson, he appears as Guardian ad-litem for William W., Laura V., Thomas H., Richard and Lucy Ann Johnson, minor children of the said deceased.)

It appears the deceased owed many debts at his death and had many notes and accounts owing him. He was in partnership with John J. Cater at his death and they were holders of public-works contracts, it appears. A reference in a return of the Administrators was made to a contract that they, the said Cater and Johnson had with the State Supt. of Public Works on which they had received a payment of \$25,000.00.)
