In Jan. 1678 Jeremiah Chaplin, came to Carolina from Barbados, in the ship "Joseph & Anne", Captain Samuel Evans, in command. The following year Thomas Chaplin, arrived from the same Island, and 5 year later i-e, in 1684 we find John Chaplin, of St Helena Isl., S.C. Testifying before the Council that he had been among the Indians, ~~and had seen arms delivered to the Yemassee~~ with whom the Spaniards were then tampering, and had personally seen arms delivered to the Yemassee.

They were all members of the Colony of Quakers, or "Friends" who came with Sir. Jacob Waite, or soon followed him, and under the patronage of Lord Shaftsbury, in 1675, settled on St Helena Isl, S.C., others who inter-married with the Waites, and Chaplins, were the Gilberts, Nortons, and perhaps the Jenkins family and others. 12,000 Acres having been set apart for them.

This little known settlement, which by the next generation had practically fused with the population, around it, had left most interesting proofs of its existence in such names as "Waites Creek" and Chaplins, Island in quaint phrasology of the preserved records of the Parish register of St Helena, showing adult baptism of several members of a family on the same date, indicating conformity of the Church of England and validation by her service of marriages previously contracted by Quaker methods.

The family record begins with John Chaplin of St Helens and Phebe, his wife, the parents and progenitors of all the Chaplins, in lower South Carolina of whom we have any record, we meet this couple only in the Parish Register and as the parents of their children.

John Chaplin, Death buried on Jan. 5th 1752 at the age of 69 1/2 years and therefore was born in July 1682 presumably on St Helena Isl S.C., This he was certainly not the John Chaplin of the Yemassee incident but most probably his son.

It is most likely that his wife Phebe was the daughter of Jacob Waite, the two families seem to have been intimately connected and the name Phebe, common in both.

died Jan. 1765, evidently a widow. She had one daughter
by her first marriage, Elinor or Ellino Reynolds, who
was married as his second wife Benjamin Chaplin, her
Step-father's brother.

As shown by records Jeremiah Chaplin ; Thomas Chaplin, and John Chaplin were brothers, leaving England on account of religion, first going to Holland, from Holland to Barbados, from Barbados, Thomas Chaplin and Jeremiah Chaplin, came to the United States, on the ship "Joseph & Ann", under command of Captain Samuel Evans, landing on St Helena, Island, S.C., John Chaplin, came to St Helena, Isl., S.C., with Sir. Jacob Waite, and under the Ppartrouage of Lord Shafteburg, in 1675 and settled on St Helena Isl., S.C., 12,000 acres of land having been set apart for the Chaplins.
