 Sarah Hinds.
 Came from London, England, to New England in ship "Elizabeth and Ann", 4-17-1635; Chandler of Bury St. Edmunds, in Suffolk County, England. (Custom House records tell no more).
 He probably brought his wife, Sarah Hinds, with him; she was the daughter of a goldsmith in that borough, but no children are ever mentioned.
 He is recorded as a freeman March 3, 1636; and soon after removed to Hartford, Conn., with Hooker and his friends; was one of the original purchasers of land in that beautiful city, but settled down in Wethersfield; was treasurer of the colony; was representative in 1643-4; and lived in 1646.
 He gave all of his estate to his wife, who went home, but date of his death or her removal are not given. (see 3 Mass. Hist. Col. x168.)

2. Hugh Chaplin, of Rowley, Mass., probably came to America with Rev. Ezekiel Rogers in 1638; was freeman May 18th, 1642; his wife was Elizabeth; Hugh died before March 1703.
