I am in receipt of your letter of July 31<sup>st</sup>. 1936 and wish to extend my sincere thanks for your <sup>early</sup> reply. Since last writing you I have obtained at Little Rock definite information about James Pto. that came to the O.S. from England.

The information is as follows:  
 (15) James Pto. came to the U.S. from Godalming, Surrey, England. The date part of the 17<sup>th</sup> century or the early part of the 18<sup>th</sup> century. Marriage record recorded in Court House at Savannah, Ga., U.S.A. : Marriage license issued to James Pto and Mary Martingale, December 17-1818.

Mary Elizabeth Martingale was the daughter of TSHHC Martingale and Elizabeth Martingale (NEE Goofey) ~~Mary Martingale (nee Goofey) was born Dec 29-1704~~
