Dear Rev. Peoples,

In my search for the parents of my ancestress Katherine De Loach Hunter I was referred to you by Mrs. E.A. Burns of the South Carolina Huguenot Society.

My great great grandfather William Hunter (RWS) of lower Orangeburg District (Census 1790) was married twice. His second wife was a Katherine De Loach, probably from upper Beaufort District. She was born around 1780, and they were married about the year 1800 - In 1833, the Hunter family along with their marriage connections moved to South Georgia.

Two of the oldest Hunter daughters Nancy and Heziah married Hiers brothers, Daniel and Phillip, sons of Jacob Hiers who lived north of the present town of Hampton, South Carolina.

When William Hunter applied for his Revolutionary War Pension the names of his heirs were listed. A copy with these

names is enclosed. It may help to decide who Katherine DeLoach was descended from.

I've noticed the names Jacob Bradbury, and James Wilson in my Hunter family since 1800 - Was the mother of Katherine DeLoach a Bradbury or a Wilson?

One family of Hunters but not my direct line carried the names Joseph and William Benjamin. I found that Benjamin was a DeLoach name along with Solomon, David, Hardy and Jesse.

A Hardy Hunter is found in the Brooks County, Georgia, Census of 1840-50 but it doesn't show up in my line of Hunters. Papers carrying the families of Hardy DeLoach Sr., and Hardy Jr. are attached.

Some years ago, I visited with Mr. J. E. Steadman of Batesburg, S.C., and Mr. Harry DeLoach of Clayton, Georgia. They both had large DeLoach files, but nothing on a DeLoach-Hunter marriage in the lower part of South Carolina, around 1800 -

This William Benjamin Hunter, shown in the Hiers Family Genealogy, is a descendent of William Hunter (RWS) who moved to South Georgia about 1833-1835, but he did not come down in the James Wilson Hunter line. He was probably raised in Georgia the son of Jacob, Henry or a Joseph Hunter.

Somewhere they picked up the De Loach name William Benjamin. It can be found in Mr. Ellis' History of the De Loach Family -

Edward Orlando Hunter's descendent's ended up in Lancaster, South Carolina.
