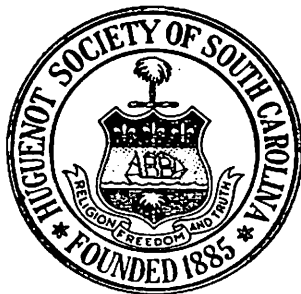

She lists her ancestor as Ensign Charles Dueitt.
