I give and bequeath to my son, Joseph my saddle + bridle likewise all wearing apparel with which he is to be well satisfied + contented.

Secondly I give + bequeath to my grandson Charles DeWitt son of James DeWitt + to his heirs or assigns a Negro Boy named Sam,

I give + bequeath to my grand daughter Kathy DeWitt dau to James DeWitt one feather bed with the furniture belonging to it

I give to son James + to his heirs or assigns a Negro Wench named Sarah with her increase together with every other Article belonging to me not disposed of in this last will + Testament

I constitute + Ordain + appoint the above named James DeWitt my son to be sole + only Ex^{or} I set my seal 20 Aug 1769 in presence of Jos Fisher + Henry Rowe + W^m Mitchell

Proved by Virtue of Obediences directed by Hon. W^m Bull Esq. 26 March 1770 at the same time
