

Dixon:

Arms of Thomas Dixon of Littleton, Cheshire b. 5 Jan. 1790

Per chevron or and gules within two chevronels, between three lions' heads erased, five fleurs de lys chevronwise and reversed alternately, all counterchanged.

Crest: A lion's head erased per fess argent and gules charged on the neck, with three fleurs de lys of the last and pierced through the mouth by an arrow, the point coming out of the back ppr. feathered argent.

Motto: Macte virtute esto
