NEW YEAR - OLD NAME

In the December issue, I asked readers for their thoughts on going back to the original name of the Estes family research publication, *Estes Trails*. Nearly everyone who wrote back agreed that it would be a good idea, if Mary Estes Beckham's family had no objections. I am pleased to report that after contacting Mary's husband, Pete, he said he would be honored and was sure that Mary would have been, to see *Estes Trails* continue.

To reiterate what long time subscribers already know, but some new readers might not, Mary Estes Beckham died in April of 1994. Mary had been involved in genealogy since 1956. She published *Historic Trails of Our Ancestors* and the *Estes Newsletter* from 1965 until 1972. From 1979 to 1982, she published *The Ancestral Circle* and in 1980 began publishing *Estes Trails*.

I never had the honor of meeting Mary and had only been a subscriber for three years, but was deeply impressed with her commitment to the Estes family and her willingness to help others in their search. Mary is and will continue to be, deeply missed!

Several readers have inquired whether or not I acquired any of Mary's research and records. I am sorry to say that I did not! Other subscribers have provided copies of books, records and research and I am doing my best to look through each reference work on each inquiry I receive. It will take some time to acquire Mary's level of experience!

SUBSCRIPTIONS

In 1995, when I took up the publication of this newsletter, I said that I wanted to provide it free for the year because I had encouraged readers to subscribe or renew their subscriptions to Mary's daughter, Carol Jean Shelby. As it turned out, Carol dropped the project after just one issue and some readers lost their money.

Many readers offered and sent contributions to the "Newsletter" in 1995 anyway, but while grateful, I returned them. After the December issue, several more readers sent contributions and encouraged me to set the publication on a financial footing. To that end, this will be the last free issue.

With and from this issue, we will be taking annual subscriptions. Those that made contributions will have that credited to their subscription. We will continue to publish four times per year, the third week of March, June and September and the last week of December. Each issue will be at least twelve pages.

RATES

The annual subscription rate will be \$10, not \$15, and will cover all publications for each calendar year. If you subscribe in 1996, you will receive all 1996 issues, even if you wait until December of 1996 to subscribe. Such a system will greatly reduce the amount of time and effort necessary to track individual subscriptions. Everyone will be on the same year, regardless of when they subscribe. For more on this strange rate system, see inside, "RATES EXPLAINED".

RATES EXPLAINED

I hope that this system makes some sense to readers. The bookkeeping, record keeping and accounting are the least-fun parts of this venture and I am trying to keep them to a minimum.

Everyone will be reminded to renew their subscription in the December issue. The following March issue will give another notice. Those that do not renew by the March issue will be taken off the mailing list and that March issue will be the last they receive. This means I will not have to send out notice after notice to those not subscribing or paying late. If you do forget and don't re-up until later in the year, you would then receive the back issues for that calendar year.

Again, the annual subscription rate is \$10.00. A subscription will cover all issues published in that calendar year, regardless of the time one subscribes. I will gladly refund the subscription rate to anyone not happy with the publication.

MISSING SOME PAGES

Last year, several researchers came forward with copies of Estes reference works, material and histories. Among these, was a copy of the now out of print, Estes Genealogy, Estes Families of Old Clay County, Missouri, by Edward and Annabelle McAllister. After having consulted it several times, looking for names to help subscribers, I find that two important pages of the index are missing, namely, pages 328 and 329.

LINE OF CHISM ESTES

This is a continuation of the John Estes and Elizabeth Chisum line begun in the December issue of the Newsletter, on page 8. I ran out of room. Many of the Texas Estes' trace their line through these families. Whether John's father is Abraham's son John or Moses is still somewhat unclear. Some good proof is still needed.

The family of Chism Estes renders his name, Chism and not Chisum, so we have honored it the same in this work. Chism was born April 3, 1774 in Halifax Co., VA. He died on Feb. 1, 1829 in Gallatin Co., IL. Chism's wife, Mary (Polly) Jordan was born on April 19, 1786 in SC. She died Aug. 3, 1859. 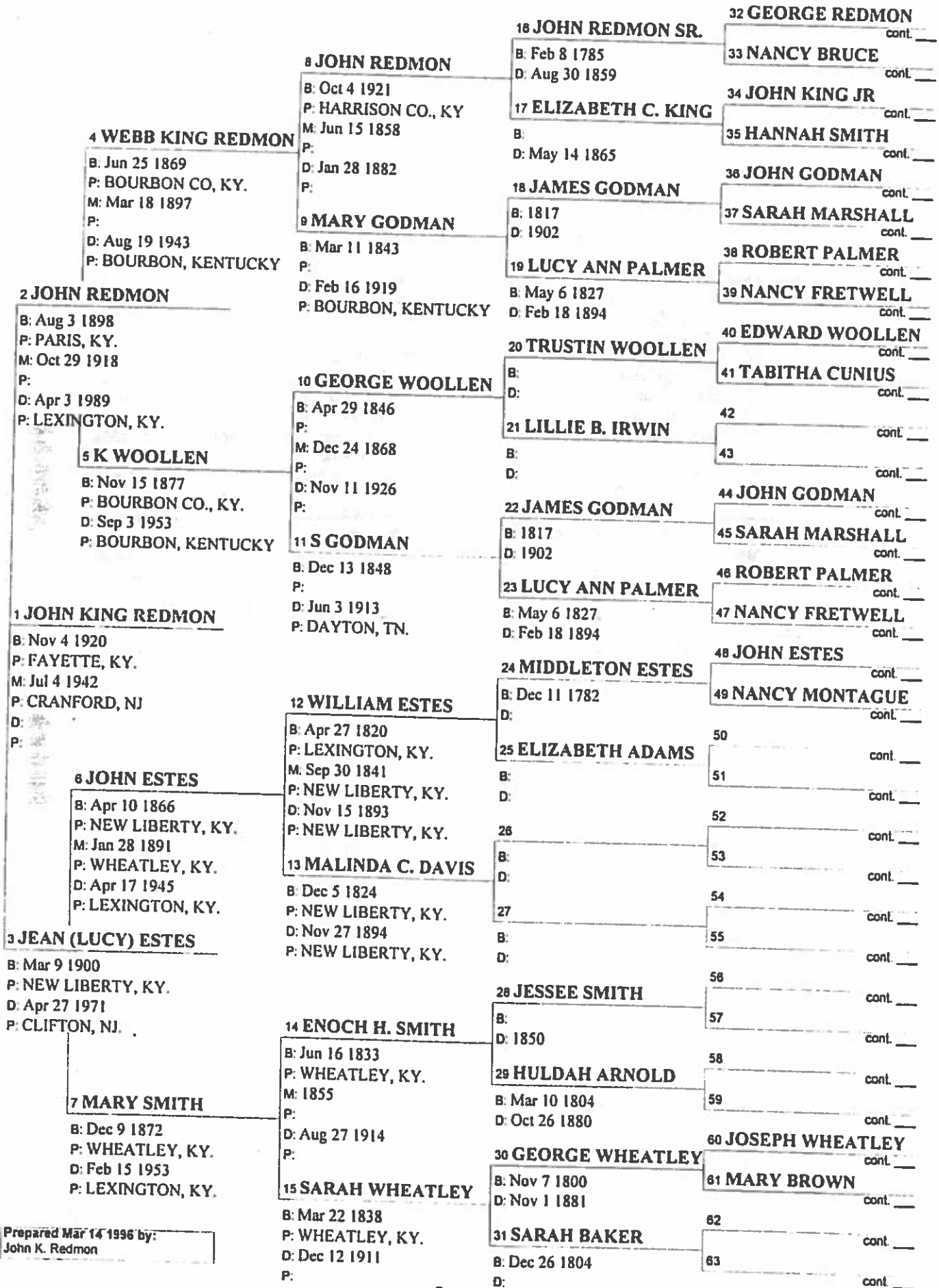
