Thomas John Smith Farr son of William Farr, born 1729, died 1794 and his second wife Elizabeth Stribling married 1752.

William Farr was Lieutenant Colonel in the army of the Revolution.

William Farr was Captain in the spartan regiment commanded by Colonel John Thomas, Sr. in the famous (snow campaign) in December 1775 he was Captain in the State Militia of South Carolina in 1776 and remained in that capacity until 1777. When the second South Carolina Regiment was organized, commanded by Colonel Thomas Brandon, William Farr was part of the time "Captain of Horse" and part of the time "Captain of Foot" he was also Adjutant and Major until 1781 when he was appointed Lieutenant Colonel serving to the middle of 1782, when the regiment was in service under General Pickens.

William Farr commanded the regiment at the battle of "Cow Pens", was present "Rocky Mount", "Hanging Rock" and "Black Stock" on Tiger River in North Carolina under General Sumpter.

Captain Daniel Cornwell was the son of Jacob Cornwell born October 1st, 1682, died January 5, 1767, married March 20th, 1711 Edith Whitmore daughter of Francis Whitmore of Middletown, Connecticut. She was born in 1688 and died June 10th, 1771. In 1713 he was called Mariner and he was granted liberty to erect a wharf in Middletown, was selectman in 1731.

Jacob Cornwell son of Jacob Cornwell born September 1646 died April 18, 1708, married January 16th, 1677 Mary daughter of Captain Nathaniel White of Middletown, Connecticut. He lived in Middletown and inherited his father's house. Joined the church in Middletown in 1668. His estate in 1708 was 406 pounds and was distributed to all his children.

Mary White died November 15th, 1732.
