near Edisto river --- 30 acres granted by the Crown to Jeremiah Fickling, father to Samuel Fickling - signed by Samuel F. Presence of George Thompson & Robert Mackenzie, Junior.

Jaudon Released 20 Sept. 1763 and recorded 11 Oct. 1763
Providence Fickling dies intestate -- " Q Q p. 117 administered 30 July 1799 maybe she dies then. James Fickling administers the estate.

Charles Pinckney Y.Y. Book -- His will is in Will Book 1783-86, pp. 43---430
made 18 April, .770 - wife is Francis

PINCKNEY
Thomas Pinckney (his father) Will Book 1694--1704, pp. 402--4

Made Oct. 27--1703 - forgot to record the date of recording - think he died about 1720 - she at once m. this West Indian named Gaere Evans.

William Brisbane W. page 105 -- John Bee is executor.

SMITH

Thomas Smith's will is 1721--1727 p. 33 Made 24 June 1722
says Thomas is the eldest son George Thomas executor
Witnessed by James Ramsey & Joseph Blake - they take oath before Paul Grimball - Capt et jurat (or p. 228)

Thomas Smith, Junior's will is 1671-1727, p. 238. Executors his brother George and Roger Sanders made Dec. 3, 1729 - gives fifty pounds to each and every dissenting minister in S.C. and 20 pounds to him who preaches my funeral sermon and to each and both of executors
