17. TERTULLE (Breton de nation), married Petronille, daughter of CONRAD, Comte de Paris; their son:
18. INGELGER, Comte Anjou, died AD 888, buried in the Church of St. Martin de Tours, married Aelinde; their son:
19. FULK I, Comte Anjou, died 938, married Roscille, Dame de Loches, daughter of Garnier, Seigneur de Loches, Villenstras and Haye; their son:
20. FULK II, Comte Anjou, died at Tours in 958, married Gerberga de Gatinais; their son:
21. GEOFFREY I, Grisgonelle, Comte Anjou, died 21 July 987, married Adelaide de Vermandois, born 950, died 975, daughter of Robert (920-967), Comte Troyes and Meaux, and his wife Adelaide, daughter of Giselbert, Comte Burgundy; their son:
22. FULK III, Comte Anjou, died on Crusade in Jerusalem 21 June 1040, married (2) Hildegarde, died 2 Apr. 1046; their daughter:
23. ERMENGARDE, Comtesse Anjou, married (2) Aubri-Geoffrey, Comte Gatinais, died 1046, son of Geoffrey III, Comte Gatinais, and his wife Beatrice de Macon; their son:
24. FULK IV, Fulk Rechin, Comte Anjou, born 1043, died 14 April 1109, married (5) in 1090 Bertrade, died 29 July 1108, daughter of Simon I, Seigneur Montfort l'Amauri, and his wife Agnes d'Evreux; their son:
25. FULK V, Comte Anjou, King of Jerusalem, born 1092, died in Jerusalem 10 Nov. 1143, married (1) in 1110 Erembourg, Comtesse de Mans, died 1126, daughter of Helias, Comte Maine, and his wife Mathilde, Dame du Chateau du Loir; their son:
26. GEOFFREY V, PLANTAGENET, Comte Anjou, Duke Normandy, born 24 Aug. 1113, died 7 Sep. 1151, married 3 Apr. 1127 Queen Matilda of England, born 1104, died 10 Sep. 1167, daughter of King Henry I of England; their son:
27. HENRY II, PLANTAGENET, King of England, died 6 July 1189, married (2) Eleanor, Duchess of Aquitaine.
