JOHN FAIREY, born Ireland c. 1720, married (1st) in Ireland c. ~~1748~~ ¹⁷³⁸ and had a son, Jesse W. Fairey, born ¹⁷⁴⁰ in Ireland; they came to S. C. in 1764 and he married (2nd) the widow ^{Sarah Elizabeth} Patrick whose daughter by her first husband, Betsy Patrick, married Jesse W. Fairey (Trustee, Sardis Meth. Ch.) John Fairey was a Revolutionary soldier and was killed at the Battle of Hanging Rock on 7 Aug. 1780; a son of John Fairey and his second wife was: ^{died 1849} (Peggy)

JOHN WILLIAM FAIREY, born c. 1772, married c. 1789 MARGARET SYPHRETT; the 1790 Census, Orangeburg Dist., S. C. shows John Fairey: "1 male 16/up, 1 female"; their daughter: ^{died 17 June 1885}

MARIAH FAIREY, born 8 July 1801, married 15 April 1819 NATHANIEL BYRD, born 6 March 1792, died 30 Nov. 1850 (son of Nathaniel Byrd, Jr. and his wife Flora who appear in 1790 Census Orangeburg Dist. "1 male 16/up, 1 male u/16, 2 females"; his father, Nathaniel Byrd, Sr. appears in 1790 Census, Orangeburg Dist.: "3 males 16/up, 4 females, 7 slaves"); Nathaniel Byrd was a member of Sardis Methodist Church near Branchville, S. C., last appearing on 1850 roll; Mariah Byrd was also a member of Sardis Methodist Church; they were parents of thirteen children, the second of whom was:
