

Jacob Folck (Folk)

Will 6 July 1775 (names only 5 of 7 known children)

Est. Inv. 4 Dec. 1777

wife Catherine (da. of John Adam Epling)

+1821 holding 150 A in fee simple, dying apparently intestate.

Ch.: John Folk (1821 released his right and interest in land of Catherine Folk to his da. Mary Magdalene Folk.)

Jacob Folk, Jr. (1812 deeded 150 A. to Catherine Folk, widow of Jacob Folk, Sr.)

---

John Henry Folk (immigrant 1753, possibly younger brother of Hans Heinrich Volch) Jacob Folk, settled in Dutch Fork, Lexington Co.

Sons:

Henry Folk, Revolutionary soldier.

George Folks

(possibly George Folk who in 1797/8 and 1811 claimed lands by settlement right in old Attakapas County, Mississippi Territory.)

---

John Conrad Folk (Volk-Foult), 1753 immigrant, possibly younger brother of Jacob Folk, settled in Dutch Fork.
