page 131 March Court 1790 "Thomas Washington having resigned serving as a constable and in his place **UCLIDAS LONGSHORE** is appointed."

page 135 June Court 1790 "ordered that a warrant of appraiserment of the goods rights & credits of WILLIAM TURNER dec'd be granted to the Ex'r directed to Henry Stidham, **UCLIDAS LONGSHORE, JOSHUA INMANN & JEHU INMAN** to appraise the same. Thomas W Waters Esquire to qualify the appraisers . . . ."

page 224 May term 1794 "on motion of Samuel Miles ordered that **UCLIDAS LONGSHORE** be appointed overseer of the Main Road leading from Bush River up to the Beaver dam and that he command all the male laboures within two miles each side of said road to keep . . . ."

Holcomb's book has other items on the INMAN family.

I do NOT know why Euclidus Longshore was missed on the 1790 Census of Newberry Co., SC.

I am pleased to learn that you have some religious convictions. My parents were So. Baptists. When I was

in high school my glee-club teacher was also choir director of the Episcopal Church (a mission church at Shawnee, Okla.) I was paid to sing tenor in the church choir. It was emphasized to me that I was paid from a special choir fund and NOT from the church treasury. The ritual was different from the Baptist church, but I felt I gained much from the sermons. After the W. War II I joined the Christian Church (Discip. of Ch.), because I thought this doctrine was closer to that of the Bible. At present with women & homosexual preachers, we disagree.
