Sept. 13, 1983

Dear Robert and Coca:

I almost gave up on trying to find any information about Gus Talb because I have called Mrs. Pitts and Geraldine Talb Sanders at least twice every day since I received your letter.

All the old Guardians have been put on ~~Micro-film~~ ^{Film} and I had to run them on the machine. As I only remembered Gus I could not remember the year but I do remember the terrible tragedy. I could not remember if it was summer or winter.

Just before it was time for the library to close this afternoon, I found the notice of death (after spending my 3rd afternoon there.)

This won't give you any definite date of birth but it is the best I can do. I did not copy the death notice word for word as it was time for the library to close.

is dated Wednesday, Jan. 7, 1931

Funeral services ~~were held~~ for
Gustava Falb, 22 year old youth,
killed on December 30, were held on
Jan 1, interment taking place in the
Beach Branch Cemetery, Curay. The
Rev. W. J. Swindell conducted the
services.

It gave a very nice account of how
well he was liked and it was a shock
to the community. It also stated that he
had traveled a lot and had only recently
returned to his home in Curay.

He was the son of the late
Mars Falb, a fine upstanding family in
the community.

It mentioned Coy C Falb of Curay, a
brother, G. W. Falb of Jacksonville, Fla another
and Miss Geraldine Falb of Taipay a sister
Geraldine married Sanders and
she is still in Taipay but I have not

her able to get her on the phone
and I did not know until today she was his sister.

Saturday, I wrote Mrs. Henry Feltz and
Geraldine Sanders and asked them to
give me the information you want
so they may send it to you direct. I'm
sure they will not know me but I
did give them the dates you gave me.

I'm sorry but I did not know anything
about this family, in fact I had never
heard of anyone until I met Gus at
grandfather's house. Mother never talked
about any of her people. I knew Aunt
Janie and had seen her a few times.
I never saw Aunt Mellie or any of her
children. I know she married
Steadmor and had a son and a daughter.
Mother did mention Mahala and Margurite
but I did not know either of them
until a few years ago.

You see we lived near my father's
people and I was very close to them.

The only had 10 going to Mexico. Last
week 4 of them decided they could not

be away from mother the first of the month and we have decided to go sometime later or I have been away almost the summer long and need to get a lot of things done and am glad the trip has been postponed. Anyway I've been there and anytime later will be better for me. I'm just plain tired.

I only saw Gus twice before he was killed but he was a person I wish I could have known. He was most interesting to talk with and had a good personality and was a handsome young man. I was in college at the time and home for Christmas holidays. I remember it was a shock to me but I did not know any of the family. At that time I honestly did not know there was any family connection and I always thought until very recently that Aunt Jessie was Uncle Ellison's wife. You see I have a picture of Aunt Janie and Aunt Jessie together.

The old saying "Ignorance is no excuse", but I never had any reason to ask, when I thought grandfather had 1 brother and 2 sisters.
