* George Riser, unmarried in 1750 from Stuttgart in Wuertemberg to Cape Fear, N.C. "from whence he came in 1751 to South Carolina at the first opportunity". Petitioned 18 Aug. 1751 for 50 A grant "in the fork between Broad and Saludy Rivers"; married Francina _____ after Aug. 1751. Served as a private in Rev. army, deserted in 1779 to Loyalist (Tory) cause but rejoined Americans and in 1781-82 furnished provisions and forage for public use. Born c. 1728, living as late as 13 Oct. 1801; parents of Mary Riser (1781-1860) who m. 1797 Jacob Copeland, Jr. (1776-3 Nov. 1853).
