Thank you for your interesting letter of Sept 10, 1986. I appreciate the information even though it doesn't solve my quest for Mary Jane Frupp.

I will write the two people you sent addresses for. I was in St. Helenas church several years ago but all I got was some published information. Perhaps I should write them. Nothing to loose.

In regard to your Judith Bartlett. She isn't in my family as far as I know because my Bartletts were in Western N.Y. State about 1800 where no records were kept and I can't trace my grandfather Ephraim P. Bartlett born 1812 back to that.

In the Bartlett information which I have collected there is: Judith Bartlett, b. Oct 17, 1726 in Newbury, Mass(?) who married Samuel Cook and moved to Compton N.H.

This information is on page 61 of "Geneological & Biographical Sketches of the Bartlett Family in England and America" by Levi Bartlett - published 1875-6

The date might be right but a doubt  
if its of any use to you.

Seems to me that there were more  
Bartlett's books then than there are now  
and I can't find any that moved to  
N.Y. state and had a son Ephraim.
