Re: JAMES GREEN, father of SAMUEL GREEN

in 1964 I think

Several years ago, I went to Charleston and searched the records at Charleston Co. Library for GREENS. I had previously found the Will of SAMUEL GREEN (father of Sarah (Green) Tucker who mar. 2nd William Pope Sr., and distributed copies of the Will to various Historical Societies. (incl. N.H.)

The 2nd search in Charleston rewarded me with the Will of Samuel's father, JAMES GREEN, April 30, 1739, Rec.1740.

Also will of JAMES GREEN JR., son of above JAMES GREEN SR. (proving a Thomas connection - which I promptly sent to Alice Tonge - and distributed copies)

The Will of JAMES GREEN SR. (wife SUSANNAH evidently dead) names following children:

- James (Jr.) -(an adult) (paren.by me -eks)
- Josiah (1723) - note by eks, he mar.Catherine Beal Spin.dau.Edw.& Cath.Beal -SCH&G 23,18
- Benjamin (1725), note by eks - he mar.Eliz.Fripp. 8/17/1752 -SCH&G, V.23, p.66

(Samuel was 12 yrs.old at time of will) ^{2 Sept.} Samuel (1727). ^{+ 27 July 1770} (by eks. He mar. Sarah Norton, 1/27/1752, his age is given as 25, and marriage date as Jan. 27, 1752 in Green Bible)

- Names daughters:
- Ann, -(by eks)- an adult. Mar.Jonathan Thomas Sr.)
 - Mary - (" " mar. probably a GRAY, see below *

* Grandson - John Gray

James Green was living in Colleton Co. in 1724, as shown by w/o Henry Walker naming him Executor. Will dated 15 Oct. 1724; prob. 17 May 1725. Rec.9 June 1725.(abstr.will in S.C.-Moore & Simmons)

will dated 5/2/1740 Rec. 8/26/1741

Will of JAMES GREEN JR. - Charleston Co.Wills 1740-1747,V.5, Bequeaths to Jonathon Thomas Jr., son of Jonathan Thomas and Ann Thomas, and refers to his brother-in-law Jonathan Thomas Sr. Therefore, proof that Ann Thomas was ANN GREEN, NAME IN THE WILL OF James Green Sr.
