Dear Cousins,

Your letter of February 21 was forwarded to us here in West Africa, which is now our temporary home while Bill is acting director of a joint project between the University of Florida, the U.S. Agency For International Development, and the Centre Universitaire de Dochang, which is Cameroon's Agricultural university. We have been located here since January 1983, and expect to be here until sometime in 1985.

As you can imagine, we are in no position now to continue our studies of family history, and don't sorry to tell you that all of our records have been placed in safe storage in Florida until our return. This is regrettable, because

the Milam - Harris line is a most interesting one, and we would like to help you pursue it. I remember an interesting drive that Bill and I made several years ago thru southwest Tennessee, when we located land records on these families in a county courthouse - believe it was Hardin Co., near Savannah, Tenn. Property was on the river, near Peckwick landing - Unfortunately we have not had an opportunity to make any further investigations. Perhaps Haddon can help you locate the information you need.

It was a pleasure to hear from you again, and we hope to renew our acquaintance when we return to the U.S.
