Samuel (Timothy) Elias Jaudon, Jr. (Daniel<sup>1</sup>, Elias<sup>3</sup>) born 17 May 1739, son of Elias Jaudon and Elizabeth Robert, married 14 Feb 1770 Mary Hyrne Smith Dixon, (17 Sep 1753 ~~on~~ James Is., SC, died 27 Jun 1797 Beaufort Dist., SC) daughter of Capt Thomas Dixon and Elizabeth Smith. Elias Jaudon owned ~~2000~~ <sup>40</sup> acres in Prince William<sup>Parish</sup>, Granville Co. on the Salkehatchee waters; 70 acres of which he sold to (brother)

Peter Jaudon on 10 May 1771; On 3 Jan 1772 he sold 200 of 400 acres on Whippey Swamp to Michael Clifton; he and wife Mary of St Peters<sup>Parish</sup> sold 300 acres <sup>known as Bulls</sup> <sup>Head of a Beaver Dam<sup>Creek</sup> Branch of Coosawatchee Swamp in St Helena<sup>Parish</sup> for £500</sup> to William Atkins, <sup>merchant</sup> <sup>and</sup> <sup>Montague</sup> <sup>Greenville</sup> <sup>buyed 4 Dec 1771 from Lord Charles</sup>

of ~~Charleston Dist.~~ <sup>St. Bartholomew's Parish 4/1</sup> On ~~Jan~~ <sup>Feb</sup> 22 Jul 1785 he was paid £20 for a horse which he <sup>lost</sup> in service. ~~He and his family~~ <sup>Militia 42</sup> is listed in the 1790 Beaufort<sup>District</sup>, SC, census with 2 males over 16, 4 males under 16, 4 females, and 14 slaves. In the 1800

Beaufort<sup>District</sup> census: 1 male 10/16, 3 males 16/26, 1 male over 45, 1 female under 10, 1 female 10/16. On 18 Jul 1809<sup>43</sup> Mr Elias Jaudon died at his plantation on ~~the~~ Black Swamp of a long and tedious illness, which he bore with Christian fortitude, in his 71st year. <sup>44</sup> The children of Elias, Jr., and Mary Jaudon were:

he received a grant of 200 acres on Black Creek in Berkeley Co. <sup>1776 ad 158 by Council of SAFETY</sup> During 1779

he served as gunsmith-repairing, cleaning <sup>30 muskets.</sup> and fixing bayonets. [The family moved to  
Prince William Parish, Beaufort Dist. <sup>after 1805</sup> On 9 Feb 1769 he married Mary Pedriar

(died 25 Jun 1776) at St Thomas/St Denis. <sup>(Bartram)</sup> They had one ~~many~~ son:

He married Anne Grimbail (born 9 Feb 1749 <sup>on Edisto Island</sup> ~~in Beaufort Dist~~) daughter of <sup>planter</sup> Paul Grimbail (1703-1750) and his 2nd wife Mary Stone. John Robert (Daniel<sup>1</sup>, Sarah<sup>4</sup>) was born 15 Jul 1742 in Santee, SC, son of Sarah Jaudon <sup>de Bourdeaux</sup> and James Robert, died 25 Feb 1826 and is buried <sup>at Cotton Hill PLANTATION, Robertville</sup> ~~at Robertville~~ Cem. <sup>19 Apr 1770</sup>

He married Elizabeth Dixon (7 Jun 1750-15 Nov 1820) daughter of Capt. Thomas Dixon <sup>He was of Granville County 3 Sep. 1764 when his father, then also of Granville Co. deeded him six tracts in</sup> and Elizabeth Smith, on 19 Apr 1770. He had a Warrant of 200 acres near Saltcatcher Swamp <sup>the Parish of St. James, Santee, their former home.</sup> 4 Jul 1769, 250 acres in Prince William Parish, Granville Co. 18 May 1771, and 250 acres

on Saltcatcher, Colleton Co. 7 Oct 1776. He served in Capt. Blakes Co. 2nd Regt SC Line <sup>He was captured by the British at the Fall of Charleston 18 May 1780 and was held 414 days as a prisoner</sup> Continental Establishment 28 Jun 1778. The children of John and Elizabeth (Dixon) <sup>was until 1 July 1781. He served an additional 148 days until 4 July 1782.</sup>
