To distinguish them we called her Grandmother. We always enjoyed visiting her. Sallie and Jasper were there and almost as young as Lois and me. Then we visited Aunt Jane, Uncle Frank and Edwin at Caves. Oh Edwin married Frances Harwin. I could not remember when I sent in what I remembered. She was from some nearby place to Columbia. Her father was a fertilizer salesman in the spring. Uncle Frank also Aunt Jane had career - after their deaths a few years later Edwin and Frances moved to Columbia. He came down once to see us, I believe after mama died. He and Frances are both dead. He was in the wholesale hardware business. I do not know if his son "little Edwin" continued the business or not.
