Paul Jaudon, Jr. (Daniel<sup>1</sup>, Paul<sup>5</sup>) was born ~~about~~ <sup>1747</sup>, ~~the~~ son of Paul Jaudon and Mararet Leibrey<sup>57</sup>, probably in the Parish of St Thomas/St Denis, where he married on 5 Jan 1772 Martha Guerin, ~~the~~ daughter of Peter Guerin and Mary Ann Norman. In 1775 he was an Executor ~~for~~ the Will of his brother-in-law James Bernard of Prince Frederick Parish, Craven Co., and was a Petit Juror in Georgetown in 1783. In 1810 he traveled <sup>to Philadelphia</sup> with Joseph J. Lawton and Thomas Polhill from SC ~~through Georgia~~ on a Georgia Passport thru the Creek nation of Indians. <sup>63</sup> In 1813 he was a Trustee at wedding of ~~his~~ <sup>his</sup> sister Judith Rebecca to Thomas Polhill, Jr., and a Witness at ~~the~~ <sup>Rev.
