"Dr. Theodore deHon Mathews (1816-1860 Rebeville)

In 1846 Dr. Theodore deHon Mathews and his wife, Mary Lawton Mathews, came by stage coach from South Carolina. .... Dr. Mathews bought a lot and built a home at the corner of Pine + Jackson streets, where the Municipal Auditorium now stands. ....

Dr. & Mrs. Mathews lived in Albany from 1846 to 1854, having during the interval lost two children who are buried in Oakview Cemetery. Mrs. Mathews's father, B. (Benjamin) T. (Themistocles) D. (D'Ion) Lawton, also died while they lived in this section and is also buried in the local cemetery; and as their health was very poor they thought it best to return to South Carolina.
