ARMS. - Argent, on a fess between three cross-croslets  
fitchy Sable, a chapefoil of the first,  
pierced of the second.

CREST. - A dog-wolf rampant argent, vulned  
in the back with, and licking the wound.

Circumciser by Lines patronus Dated 14 R.
