hundred and forty three dollars to me paid, by Guyler Vickry,
the receipt whereof I hereby acknowledge, have granted, bargained,
sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain
sell and release unto the said Guyler Vickry a certain tract
or parcel of land being a portion of a tract of land conveyed
to me by my father, Roff T. Lawton on the 8th day of April
1864 bounded north by lands belonging to Baze more, East by
lands belonging to John H. Mercer and west by lands belong-
ing to E. B. Griff and Georgia Lawton, containing one hundred
and sixty one acres more or less, and having such form
and marks as a plat hereunto annexed will more fully show:

To have and to hold the said premises with all and
singular the rights, members and appurtenances thereunto appur-
taining, to the only proper use, benefit and behoof of him
the said Guyler Vickry, his heirs executors administrators and
assigns in fee simple. And the said Georgia Lawton the said
bargainer premises unto the said Guyler Vickry, his heirs, executors,
administrators and assigns, against the said Georgia Lawton resellers,
executors and administrators, and against all and every other
person or persons, shall and will warrant and forever defend
by virtue of these presents.

 in consideration of the sum of One hundred and fifty dollars to
 me in hand paid by William H Anderson the receipt whereof is
 hereby acknowledged, hath bargained and sold and by these presents
 doth bargain sell, release and convey unto the said William H
 Anderson all that tract or parcel of land situate lying and being
 in the County and State aforesaid on the water of Black Creek contain-
 ing Eighty four acres more or less, bounded on the north by lands of
 William Anderson on the South by lands of W D Anderson senior on
 the East by lands of W A Bennett and on the west by lands of William
 Anderson. To have and to hold said lands together with all
 and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances
 to the same belonging, or in anywise incident to or appertaining
 to his own use and behoof forever. And I the said William
 Colson do hereby bind myself my heirs, executors and administrators
 to warrant and forever defend the said lands unto the said W H
 Anderson his heirs and assigns forever against myself my heirs and
 all persons whosoever claiming the same or any part thereof.
