Philip's will was probated 24 May 1839- From Holidaysburg's Registry and Floyd G. Hoenstine. The Holidaysburg Register of 29 May 1839 gives his age as 17 May 1839 age 71 years 1 month & 19 days. His wife Jane died 10 Aug. 1831, age 66 years, 10 months. John was the youngest son of Jacob & Mary (Hammer) Roller. (More information p577 from "Blair County, PA." by Wiley & Garner. Of fourteen childre, eleven attained mature years. This artical lists a son George and the youngest son John Milton, died when a youth.

Phillip was the youngest son of Jacob Roller, Sr. He served in the war of 1912 under Commador Perry on Lake Erie. He always lived in Sinking Valley, PA. Many descendents live in Blair County and Huntingdon County, at Williamsburg, Hollidaysburg, Alexandria and Yellow Springs.

Philip was the youngest son of Jacob Roller; a soldier in the war of 1812 under Commodore Perry on Lake Erie; he remained in Linking Valley, PA. Many descendants live in Blair and Huntington Counties, at Williamsburg, Hollidaysburg, Alexandria and Yellow Springs.

Jacob, Jr., & Balser, sons of Jacob Roller were enrolled in the Continental Army of 1776. They were assigned to the frontier, where they and their com-patriots repelled many an Indian attack. Standing on the dangerous picket line, they became frontier guards to the settlements in the rear.

Dear Mrs. Mozley:

As requested by your letter of March 8th with remittance of \$15.00, a survey of records in my library has been made and many references are found which supports the "Historical Sketch of the Descendants of Jacob Roller", 1929, as furnished. This report will deal primarily with your ancestors John and Michael Roller, sons of Jacob, Senior.

Inscriptions from headstones located in cemeteries in Tyrone Township, Blair County, have been copied in recent years but none found for Jacob, Senior or Jacob, Junior. The headstone for Philip is found in the Presbyterian cemetery at Arch Spring and reads died May 17, 1839, aged 71 years, 1 month and 19 days. His wife Jane died August 10, 1831, aged 66 years, 10 months.

The records giving the year of death for Jacob Roller, Senior as 1781 is incorrect as his will is recorded at Huntingdon, county seat of Huntingdon County, Vol. 1, page 228, dated March 1803 and probated January 23, 1804. He mentioned Catherine Wiskee, spinster, as housekeeper, and children:

Executors: sons Michael and Henry.

Item 314, in my rental library, Biographical Encyclopedia of Blair County, by Wiley and Gardner, 1892, devotes several pages to the Roller family and on page 577 gives Peter as the youngest son. Possibly he died single prior to the death of his father.

Strassberger's, Pennsylvania German Pioneers, Vol. I, page 438, mentions the arrival of one Jacob Roller who took the oath of allegiance to Great Brittain at the courthouse in Philadelphia on 28 August 1750, being imported on the Ship Two Brothers from Rotterdam. This could have been your ancestor but proof is lacking.

The Pennsylvania Archives, lists one Jacob Roller as being assessed with 2 horses and one cow, in Berks County 1767. Jacob Roller, Senior is first assessed in Bedford County in the year 1776 indicating settlement in 1775 as the assessments were made the previous year. At that time he was assessed with an occupation and as an inmate (renter). Prior to the above year his name appears in the assessment of Hopewell Township, Bedford County, for the years 1774 and 1775. Huntingdon County was formed from Bedford County in 1787 and Blair County from Huntingdon in 1846.

The Archives lists military service during the Revolutionary War for John Roller as follows:

Third Series, Vol. XXIII, page 232, John Rowler, Private, Rangers on the Frontier, Capt. James Johnson, Bedford County, 1778-1783.

Fifth Series, Vol. IV, page 249, John Rowler, Private, Depreciation Pay, Bedford County Militia. Page 612, John Rowler, Private, Continental Line, Bedford County Militia.

The Military services for Michael Rowler appears in the Third Series, pages 232 and 237, as a Private, Rangers on the Frontier, Capt. James Johnson, Bedford County Militia, 1778-1783.

Also in the Fifth Series, Vol. IV, pages 249 and 612, as a Private, Continental Line, Bedford County Militia, Depreciation Pay.


Balsler served with the Rangers with John and Michael but the names of Caleb and Henry do not appear in available records.

I have a complete record of the assessments of the Sinking Valley area which shows John Roller as first assessed in 1785 with two horses as an inmate, Sinking Valley, Tyrone Township, until 1795. Michael is assessed in 1779 as a Single Freeman, until 1805.

The area of Sinking Valley was reserved as a Manor by the Penn Family and land was not sold there until after the Revolutionary War when the Penn rights were extinguished. Fort Roberdeau was erected in Sinking Valley in 1778 and it is likely that members of the Roller family participated in its construction and the protection it offered; however, the Roller family constructed a log fort near their residence. The encounter with the Indians and the death of Jacob, Jr., probably in 1781, are told in Jones' History of the Juniata Valley.

EXCERPTS FROM PUBLICATION:- HISTORICAL SKETCHES of the DESCENDENTS OF JACOB ROLLER. Compiled for the Fiftieth Anniversary of the ROLLER RE-UNION, Washingtonville, OH 15 August 1929.

Among the enjoyable features of the first reunion was the reading of an historical sketch, prepared by a committee composed of Jacob Roller, William B. Roller and Simon Roller. This record has been preserved and with additional information acquired from time to time is now available for the purpose of this book. To these first efforts we are greatly indebted and will endeavor to quote as far as is practicable within our necessarily limited space.

Jacob Roller, the federal head of this history, was a native of Wurttemberg, Germany; born of poor parents, though established ancestry, the family enjoyed the distinction of a coat of arms. He came to America about the year 1740 or 1745, being twenty-one years of age. He sold his time to a farmer, working three years faithfully to pay his passage across the Atlantic. Soon after this he married Miss Mary Hammer, a German lady who was also from Wurttemberg. By this union they became the parents of seven sons and two daughters, viz.: Sons: JACOB, MICHAEL, JOHN, BALSER, PHILIP, HENRY, and Caleb; Daughters: MARY and Margaret. The above parents lived and died in Pennsylvania.

Settling in York, PA., Jacob Roller engaged in chopping cord wood at Grubb's Iron Works; he afterwards removed to Bedford county, now Huntingdon county, Pennsylvania just before the Revolutionary war, and being on the frontier they had to live in forts. Their fort was named Standing Stone, now the city of Huntingdon, and during the seven years of the Revolutionary struggle to throw off the British yoke and become a free people the Roller family was ready and willing at every call to respond to the cause of liberty, and for the the seven long years they never went out to work but with their guns to quell the Indians. Jacob, the eldest son, was killed by the Indians on 3rd August 1783.

In 1776 upon the opening of government land, Jacob Roller purchased a section known as Sinking Valley, Now Blair county, where his home was established. In this section today live many Rollers, descendants of his sons, Philip and Jacob, who did not move with their brothers in their western migration; also, the descendants of the Burleys and Igoes.

Jacob Roller sailed from Rotterdam, Holland on the ship "Two Brothers" captained by Thomas Arnot commanding touching port Cowes, England and landed in Philadelphia 28 August 1750. He took the usual oath of allegiance to the King of England. He then went to Lancaster county which later became York county. They started their family here (some were born at Sinking Valley). About 1774 or 1775 he came to the valley of Sinking Springs in Bedford county and took out a patent for a tract of land of 370 acres of virgin forest. Here they built a home and stockade and was known as Fort Roller.

Mr. Roller died after 1803. He was preceded in death by his wife Mary. They are buried somewhere on the farm near Fort Roller.

The subject's grandfather was for a number of years pastor of the Presbyterian church of Hanover, having come here from Scotland at a very early date. Dr. S. S. Robertson was born in Hanoverton, July 14, 1830, and received his early education in the public schools of the town, afterward attending the academy at Salem for a limited period. He subsequently entered Jefferson college, Pennsylvania, from which he graduated in the year 1848, and shortly thereafter began the study of medicine under his father at Hanoverton. After pursuing his professional reading for some time, he took a course at the Cleveland Medical college, now known as the Western Reserve university, and began the practice of his profession with Dr. Haldeman, of Minerva, a partnership which continued two years. He then went to Salineville where he practiced for a time, and in 1871, located at Hanoverton, where he has since remained in the enjoyment of a large and lucrative business. As a practitioner the doctor has few equals in this part of the state, and as a well posted physician fully abreast of the times, he ranks with the well-known medical men of eastern Ohio. He was married September 20, 1853, to Miss Elmira Pool, of Minerva, who was born February 5, 1837. The result of this union has been four sons and one daughter, viz.: Clarence P., connected with one of the national banks of New York city; Willard L., of Denver, Col.; Frank H., a resident of Englewood, a suburb of Chicago; Norman C., of Hanoverton and Mrs. Flora Schrag, of Allegheny City, Penn. The doctor is an active member of the F. & A. M., and I. O. O. F., societies, and socially occupies a prominent place in the estimation of the people of Hanoverton.

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Samuel J. Roller, a respected citizen of Hanover township, was born in Mahoning county, October 15, 1837, the son of Jacob B. and Margaret (Gilbert) Roller, of whom mention is found elsewhere in this volume. At the age of eleven years Mr. Roller began working at the miller's trade with his father, and on attaining his majority went to New Lisbon, Ohio, at which place he operated a saw-mill until 1862. In that year he ran a flouring-mill for a short time in West Fork, and in August enlisted in Company G, One Hundred and Fourth Ohio volunteer infantry as a musician, with which he served until the close of the war. On the 10th day of August, 1864, he was taken prisoner near Atlanta, Ga., by the Texas Rangers and stripped of everything but shirt and pants. Shortly afterward he became an inmate of the infamous prison pen of Andersonville, where for eight months and eight days he suffered untold tortures, the like of which caused the death of many of his unfortunate comrades. He went into the prison weighing 175 pounds, and when he came out his weight had diminished until he could scarcely tip the beam at seventy-five or eighty pounds. While a pris-

oner he was changed around considerably. After the fall of Atlanta he, with a number of others, was loaded in box cars and transported to Milan, where, in the prison stockade, he experienced his greatest suffering from the intense cold and exposure. From Milan he was transferred to Savannah, thence to Blackshier, where the prisoners were put in an open field, surrounded by a deep trench, which was carefully watched by cruel guards. They were then sent to Savannah for exchange, but the transports not arriving, he was taken back to Blackshier, thence to Thomasville, on the Florida line, and a short time afterward to Albany, where they were obliged to march on foot through the swamps and water which caused great suffering, the time being the week of Christmas, and the weather very cold and disagreeable. He was afterwards returned to Andersonville, where he remained until April, after which with others, he was compelled to make various changes before his parole on the 28th day of April, 1865, at Lake City, Fla. After his parole he was sent under guard to Baldwin, at which place he first breathed the air of liberty after his long incarceration. He then went on foot to Jacksonville, where he received an outfit of new clothing, after which he went on a river steamer to Fernandina, and there took an ocean steamer for Annapolis, Md., where he arrived on the 4th day of May, 1865. After remaining in that city a short time, and drawing \$61.75 commutation money, he was sent to Columbus, where on the 16th day of the following June he received his discharge. After this he returned to Salem. Mr. Roller has in his possession a pocket-book and skillet (the latter he got in Andersonville) which he carried through the war; the skillet he looks upon as an especially valuable article, as it served him to bake what little bread was allowed him during the trying days of his prison experience. Mr. Roller was married September 12, 1861, to Miss Caroline Heaton, who was born December 30, 1840. To this union have been born six children, all of whom survive except the eldest son. Their names are: Mrs. Ada R. Reader, Charles E., Walter G., Homer H., Edith C., and Jessie I., who died May, 1867. Mr. Roller is a member of the G. A. R. post, of New Lisbon, and with his wife belongs to the Trinity Reformed church. May 3rd, Mr. Roller was nominated by the republican primary election for infirmary director, receiving a handsome majority over all competitors. In March, 1877, he purchased a piece of land and a mill in Hanover township, and since that time has been in business here. He is an ardent supporter of the republican party, and a man universally respected by the community in which he resides.

W. C. KOLLER, M. D. The community of Willshire

in Van Wert County has been well served in a professional capacity by Doctor Koller, who has practiced medicine and surgery there for a quarter of a century. He is one of the able and competent members of his profession.

September 2, 1870, son of A. J. and Mary J. (Guthrie) Koller. His youthful days were spent on the farm, and after making the best possible use of the normal school at Middle Point, Ohio, and also the Tri-State Normal College at Angola, Indiana. For five years Doctor Koller was a successful teacher, doing that work partly as a means toward finishing his medical education. Doctor Koller is a graduate with the class of 1898 from the Cincinnati College of Medicine and Surgery. After his graduation he returned to Van Wert County and took up practice, and has been one of the busiest men in his profession in the county. During the World War he volunteered and was commissioned a first lieutenant in the Medical Corps, and was assigned to duty at Camp Greenleaf, Chickamauga Park, Georgia. He is a member of the Van Wert County and Ohio State Medical associations. He is also a stockholder in the Farmers and Merchants Bank of Willshire.

Doctor Koller married Ida Van Swearingen, of Monticello, Ohio. She is well educated and was also a teacher before her marriage. They have one child, R. Fay, born November 18, 1895, and a graduate of the Willshire High School. He is an electrician at Fort Wayne, Indiana. He married Dove Gully and they have a child, Billie Jean, born June 2, 1921. Doctor Koller is on the Official Board of the Methodist Episcopal Church. He belongs to the Masonic Lodge No. 667 at Willshire, is a member of the Scottish Rite Consistory at Toledo and the Temple of the Mystic Shrine at Chattanooga, Tennessee.

DAVER J. HARKMAN has had a busy career in his native county of Van Wert, a farmer, lumber manufacturer and banker. He is president of the Bank of Wren and is also president and manager of the Wren Telephone Company. He was born on a farm near Wren, November 10, 1862, son of Peter and Matilda (Marks) Harkman. His father was born in Fairfield County, Ohio, in 1826, and died March 20, 1892, and his mother was born in 1824, and died December 16, 1902. Both grew up in pioneer times, had such advantages as the common schools of that day could bestow, and soon after their marriage they moved from Fairfield County to Van Wert County. They settled on government land, which in time became a prosperous and well improved farm, and on it they spent the rest of their useful and honored lives. They were very devout Christians, active members of the United Brethren Church, and in politics Peter Harkman always voted the democratic ticket. They were the parents of six children, rearing four. Three sons are still living, all in Van Wert County, John, a farmer in Willshire Township; Lewis M., vice president of the Bank of Wren; and Oliver J.

Oliver J. Harkman was reared on a farm, and has been more or less closely identified with farming all his active career. He was educated in the public schools. He married Miss Eva A. Stentz, who was born in York Township, Van Wert County, May 21, 1880. Mr. and Mrs. Harkman have two children

sold. After that he looked after his farming and other investments, and in 1922 established the Ford Agency at Willshire, under the firm name of Braub & Chilcote. He gives most of his time to this business. He is also a director of the Farmers and Merchants Bank of Willshire, is interested in several parcels of real estate in the town, and has a farm of 140 acres in Willshire Township.

Mr. Chilcote married Miss Dora Brenner, of Canoy, Ohio, in 1890. She is a member of the Methodist Church at Willshire. Mr. Chilcote is a post master of Willshire Lodge No. 667, Ancient Free and Accepted Masons, belongs to the Royal Arch Chapter, the United and Knight Templar Comandery at Van Wert, and the Scottish Rite Consistory and the Mystic Shrine at Cincinnati. He is a past worthy patron and his wife is a past worthy matron of the Eastern Star Chapter. He also belongs to the Independent Order of Odd Fellows at Willshire and in politics is a republican. For twenty years Mr. Chilcote served as a treasurer of the town of Willshire.

WILLIAM E. SPITLER has been a resident of Willshire for over a quarter of a century and for most of the time since locating there has been a grocery merchant, supplying a wide extent of territory with provisions. He has an up-to-date store in one of the progressive agricultural communities of Van Wert County.

He was born at Lancaster in Fairfield County, Ohio, May 26, 1872, son of Jesse D. and Dora (Harmon) Spitzer. His father was born in Fairfield County, June 4, 1846, grew up on a farm, getting a common school education, and at the age of seventeen went away as an enlisted man in the Union Army to fight the battles of the Civil War. He was wounded, and he was in Sherman's army on the march to the sea. After his return to Fairfield County he married and settled on a farm. In 1875 he moved to Mercer County and lived on a farm there for nearly thirty years. In 1904 he removed to Willshire, and is now living retired. His wife died several years ago. He is a member of the radical branch of the United Brethren Church and in politics is a democrat. There are four children: William E.; Ora, wife of Mr. Spitzer, Ohio; Ethel, wife of Orville Ayres, of La Grange, Indiana; and Ed, of Geneva, Indiana.

William E. Spitzer from the age of three lived on his parents' farm in Mercer County, Ohio. He attended common schools there, also the schools of Middle Point, and most of his working experiences through youth and early manhood were connected with the farm.

In May, 1897, he married Miss Ethel A. Byer, a native of Mercer County, where she was reared and educated. After their marriage Mr. and Mrs. Spitzer moved to Willshire, where he engaged in the grocery business, and with brief exceptions has followed that line ever since. He and Mrs. Spitzer have five children: (they are graduates of high school and of a business college at Fort Wayne, Indiana, now the wife of Miles Joss, of Willshire; Glenn, who married Rosa Brandon, and Jesse, both graduates of high school and associated with their father in the grocery business; Mary, a graduate of high school and assistant cashier in the Farmers and Merchants Bank of Willshire; and Clark, the youngest child, who is attending high school.

The family are members of the Methodist Episcopal Church, and Mr. Spitzer is one of the Official Board. He is serving in one of the chairs of the Knights of Pythias lodge and in politics is a democrat. In addition to his business as a merchant he is serving as township treasurer of Willshire Township, is a director of the Farmers and Merchants

Dear Mr. Roller:

Enclosed is your typed form--I hope it's o.k. I added a little information on the family of Wm & Nancy Teeters Roller which I recently acquired from Mrs. Margaret Roller Burnap, granddaughter of Wilson Monroe Roller. Am sure it's reliable. Mrs. Burnap is 81 yrs old, lives in Findlay, and is compiling data on her branch of the family. She responded to one of my "Roller Family" letters such as you received, by telephone. (I had sent 3 of those.) We then went to Findlay and had a very nice visit with her and her husband, who, incidentally, has done a lot of research on his line.

Mrs. Burnap had a copy of a Roller family chart which she gave us. She had it for years and does not recall the name of the man who gave it to her. He had attended the Roller Reunion at Findlay a long time ago. It's on a parchment or vellum paper which has so yellowed with age that we have been unsuccessful in copying it. However, we did get it translated by friends who were born & raised in Germany and can read the old-fashioned German script. At least, we have most of it translated--a few words eluded them. In the upper left hand corner is a coat of arms almost, but not quite, the same as the one in our 1929 reunion booklet. The particular Roller line starts with Johann Georg Roller, White tanner, Son of the House Roller, from Wildberg, Wurttemberg, married in Balingen 1643. His children are named, then the children of one of them, on down the line. 8 generations are listed, the last of which was American born, their father having immigrated in 1854. He was Johann Jacob Roller, born in Balingen 9 June 1829, and was a red tanner over there. Most of the occupations shown were white or red tanner. Some others hdd to do with leather. A number of Jacobs appear, but not ours. I would be surprised, though, to learn that our Jacob was not connected with this family somehow.

A number of places were mentioned: Wildberg, Balingen, Eichstatt, Esslingen, Weinsberg, all in the southern part of Germany. We have written to a friend of my husband's in Ludwigsberg, near Stuttgart, in an endeavor to locate a published genealogy or history of the Roller Family. Apparently there were many, many Rollers and they were an established family. Perhaps there is something available.

Ray and I were at the library in Ft. Wayne last week and while we were there they put a new series of books on the shelves, printed in the German language, on Germany families. Must be over 100 books in the set, but the one that, according to the index, shows the Roller Family did not come in. We'll just have to look for it the next time. Did copy a number of pages, though, that showed marriages between Rollers and other families.

Also checked the 1880 Census (Soundex microfilms) and was amazed at the number of Rollers in Indiana and Ohio who were not of our Jacob Roller line. Again, many Jacobs-.

I don't know when we might get up to your area but hope to do so as soon as we can.

Thank you very much for all of the information on your line. You did a beautiful job of filling out our long complex form. It is one that we had printed (I typed up the masters for it) but I think it scares a lot of people. Am enclosing a couple of them for your other lines.

THE FAMILY OF JOSEPH M. AND FLORA BLACK ROLLER

Being the lone survivor of the nine children of Joseph M. and Flora Black Roller since the death of William Guy a few months ago, I feel I should jot down some of the facts and data concerning the history and background of the family. Our children and grandchildren may be wishing for such information one of these days. If this record proves helpful in any way, I'll feel grateful and know my effort has not been in vain.

Among the first pioneers to settle in Mahoning County, Ohio were two brothers by the name of Roller, who came there from Germany. John R. Roller, a grandson of one of these brothers was born in 1818. He was a native of (Greenwood) Township, Mahoning County, where he was reared and followed the occupation of farming. It was there he met and married Susanna Fox, who was born in Columbiana County in 1821. They were the parents of nine children:

The family moved to Van Wert County in September 1865, and settled in York Township on a tract of 60 acres of uncleared land. In a month's time they had made a little clearing and had a small cabin built for the family. It was just eleven months after their arrival that John became seriously ill and died. The family stayed on -- the mother and sons farming the land. Tragedy struck the household again in 1870 when the youngest child, Harriet, age 5, became ill and died.

The Roller family is numbered among the hardy pioneers of Van Wert County, for the most primitive conditions prevailed when they came to this region. All the land in the vicinity of their home was covered with trees, and a common amusement for the boys was the hunting of porcupines, turkeys and raccoons.

Joseph M. Roller was born in Mahoning County, Ohio on November 27, 1851, the fifth child in the family of John R. and Susanna Fox Roller. He received his primary schooling in Mahoning County, and was fourteen years of age when the family moved to Van Wert County. He attended school one winter after their move. Later he took a course at Ohio Normal University in Ada, Ohio, and also attended private school in his own district for two seasons. Following this training, he taught school seven winters in Van Wert County and one winter in Mercer County. On September 20, 1877, he was married to Flora Black the oldest daughter of William and Margaret Like Black.

William Black was the son of Henry and Susannah Cary Black. Both William and Margaret were natives of Perry County. They were married November 8, 1857. Eleven children were born to them:

Four of these children died in infancy. Amos 10 months, Edward 2 months, Curtis 2 years, Rosswell 2 years. William Black enlisted as a private in the 162 nd Regiment, Ohio Volunteer Infantry; later became a corporal, and was discharged as a sergeant at the end of the Civil War. His father and four brothers also served in the Union Army. The youngest brother serving as a drummer boy was killed. Because of exposure and inadequate medical care during his military service, William Black sustained a bad eye infection and as a result was blinded in one eye. After his discharge he rejoined his family, who in the meantime had moved to Paulding County. They remained there eleven years, then purchased a farm in Van Wert County, moving there in 1876. William and Margaret Black spent the rest of their lives in Jennings and York Townships.

For several years after their marriage Joseph M. and Flora Black Roller lived in York Township and one summer in Ridge Township. In 1893 they bought 40 acres in Liberty Township. The entire farm was woodland. The family moved into a log house on a neighboring farm in 1896 and started clearing the land. The barn was erected in 1897, and the house was ready for occupancy in 1899. At this time I was one year old, Edna, the oldest sister was married and living in Middlepoint. 1899 was an eventful year for the family. It was high-lighted by the move into the new home, the first grandchild was born, Doyt C. Gamble and the second daughter, Ethel, was married.

Joseph Roller was a successful farmer. The family took an active part in community and church affairs. They were members of the Methodist Church in Ohio City, and they belonged to the Knights and Ladies of the Maccabees. After several months of failing health and illness from a heart condition and Edema, Joseph Roller died in August 1921. He is buried in Woodlawn Cemetery, near Ohio City

Following his death, Flora Roller stayed on the farm a few months, then purchased a house on South Main Street in Ohio City, making that her home for several years. During the winter of 1930-31 she fell in her home, breaking a hip. She never recovered completely from this mishap. After several weeks in the hospital, Sister Edna came from Akron to be with her for a while. They spent the summer at the farm house and that fall, Mother came to Sidney and spent her last two years with me. She died May 19, 1933.
