\*9. Rt. Hon. Thomas Smith, Landgrave and Governor of South Carolina, born at Exeter, England, 1648, died at Charleston, South Carolina, 16 November 1694, married first in England 1668, Barbara Atkins, ~~his step-sister~~, born at Chard 1650, died at Charleston 1689. Thomas Smith was in 1691 constituted the first Landgrave by that name in the Carolina Province, with four baronies of 12,000 acres each, "the said title and four baronies to descend forever to his legal heirs."

23. Isabel Bigod married second John FitzGeoffrey, Justice of Ireland, died 23 November 1258.

22. Aveline FitzGeoffrey, died about 20 May 1274, married Walter de Burgh, Earl of Ulster, died 28 July 1271.

21. Richard de Burgh, Earl of Ulster, born 1259, died 29 July 1326, married (21) Margaret Burgh, died about 1303, who was descended as follows:

20. Elizabeth Burgh, who married (20) KING ROBERT BRUCE, born 11 July 1274, crowned King of Scotland 25 March 1306, died 7 June 1329. He was descended as follows:

26. DAVID I, King of Scotland, son of King Malcolm III (Canmore) hallowed by the people as a saint but not canonized, born 1030, died 1153, a wise and just king, married in 1113 Matilda, died 1131, daughter of Walthof, Earl of Northumberland.

25. Henry, Prince of Scotland and Earl of Huntingdon, died 1152, married in 1139 Ada Warren.

24. David, Earl of Huntingdon, knighted by King Henry II in 1170, died 17 June 1219, younger brother of Malcolm and William, Kings of Scotland. He married Maud, daughter of Hugh de Kevelioc, Earl of Chester. Their daughter

23. Isabel of Huntingdon, married Robert Bruce, 4th Baron of Annandale, son of William Bruce. Robert died in 1245, and Isabel died in 1252.

22. Robert Bruce, born 1210, died 1295, unsuccessful contestant for the Throne of Scotland, married first (22) Isabel Clare, born 1226, living 1264, who was descended as follows:

24. RICHARD de CLARE the Surety, q. v., 4th Earl of Hertford, died 1217, married Amicia of Gloucester.

23. GILBERT de CLARE the Surety, q. v., born about 1180, died 25 October 1230, married Isabella Marshall.

(22) Isabel Clare as above married 22 Robert Bruce and had

21. Robert Bruce, born 1243, died 1304, married in 1271 Martha (called also Marjorie) Carrick, great great granddaughter of Fergus, lord of Galloway.

(20) KING ROBERT BRUCE as above married 20 Elizabeth Burgh and had

19. Matilda Bruce, who married "a certain squire," Thomas Isaac. She died 20 July 1353 and was buried in Dunferm.

18. Joanna Isaac married John MacAlan of Ergadia, lord of Lorne in 1338. In 1357 he had a grant of all the lands in Lorne that had belonged to Alexander de Lorne. They were the parents of

17. Isabel Ergadia, who married Sir John Stewart of Innermeath. He exchanged his paternal estate of Durrisdeer with his Brother Robert and wife, presumably for a moiety of the lordship of Lorne.

16. Isabel Stewart, died 26 October 1510, married before 9 April 1465 Sir Colin, 2d Lord Campbell and 1st Earl of Argyll, master of the King's household in 1464, ambassador to the courts of England and France and, in 1483, Lord High Chancellor of Scotland. He was the son of Archibald Campbell and his wife Elizabeth Somerville.

15. Archibald Campbell, Earl of Argyll, slain 9 September 1513 at the Battle of Flodden, married Elizabeth, eldest daughter of John Stewart, 1st Earl of Lennox and his wife Margaret Montgomery.

14. Isabella Campbell, second daughter, married Gilbert Kennedy, 2d Earl of Cassillis, son of Sir David Kennedy and his wife Agnes Borthwick. Sir Gilbert was in Edinburgh on 24 August 1527, and in the following month he was assassinated by Sir Hugh Campbell of Loudoun, sheriff of Ayr.

13. Gilbert Kennedy, 3d Earl of Cassillis, born 1515, became heir to his father 14 October 1538. He was a man of affairs and attended the Parliaments of Scotland with considerable regularity from 1535 until the close of his life. In 1558 he became a Protestant through the preaching of Archbishop Cranmer. He married in 1540 Margaret Kennedy, daughter of Alexander Kennedy of Bargany. Their son

12. Gilbert Kennedy, 4th Earl of Cassillis, popularly styled "King of Carrick," born 1541, died 14 December 1576, the result, it is said, of his horse falling with him. He married (contract 30 September 1566) (12) Margaret Lyon, died at Evandail in 1626, who was descended as follows:

26. SAIRE de QUINCEY the Surety, q. v., Earl of Winchester, born before 1154, died 3 November 1213, married Margaret Beaumont (Bellomont).

25. Roger de Quincey, second son, who held his father's estates while his brother Robert was in the Holy Land, succeeded as Earl of Winchester in 1235, and died 25 April 1264. He married first Helen MacDonal, daughter of Alan MacDonal, lord of Galloway, and his first wife Ragnhild, daughter of Reginald of the Isles. Helen was ninth in descent from King Malcolm II of Scotland.

24. Ela Quincey, died 1296, married Alan la Zouche, died 1269 a descendant of the Earls of Brittany.

23. Roger la Zouche, died 1285, married Ela, daughter of Emeline of Ulster and her husband Stephen Longespee.

22. Alan la Zouche, born 1267, died 1314, married Eleanor daughter of Nicholas de Segrave.

21. Maude Zouche, died 31 May 1349, married Sir Robert de Holand, born about 1270.

20. Thomas de Holand, K. G., Earl of Kent, married Joan Plantagenet, daughter of Edmund of Woodstock, son of KING EDWARD I, q. v.

19. Thomas de Holand, K. G., Earl of Kent, died 25 April 1397. He married (19) Alice FitzAlan, died 17 March 1415/6, who was descended as follows:

25. ROBERT de VERE the Surety, q. v., hereditary lord great Chamberlain of England, died 25 October 1221, married Isabe Bolebec.

24. Hugh de Vere, 4th Earl of Oxford, died 1263, married in 1223 Hawise Quincey, daughter of SAIRE de QUINCEY the Surety No. 26 above.

23. Robert de Vere, 5th Earl of Oxford and 6th great Chamberlain, born 1240, died 2 September 1296. He married Alice, died September 1317, daughter of Gilbert de Saunford.

22. Joan Vere married William de Warren, who was killed in his father's lifetime in a tournament at Croydon, 15 December 1285

21. Alice Warren, died before 23 May 1338, married 1305 Edmund FitzAlan, Earl of Arundel, born 1 May 1285, beheaded 17 November 1326.
