 2. Robert de Todenei, Standard Bearer at Hastings 1066, married Adela, died Aug. 1088, Lord of Belvoir Castle, Lincolnshire. Arms: gules, a lion rampant or, armed and langued argent.
 3. William d'Albini, Baron Belvoir, died 1155, married Maud de Senlis, daughter of Simon, Earl Northampton and Huntingdon.
 4. William Meschines d'Albini, 2nd Baron Belvoir, died 1186.
 5. William d'Albini, 3rd Baron Belvoir, Magna Carta Surety, died May 1, 1236, married Margery, daughter of Odonel, Baron Umfraville.
 6. William d'Albini, died 1285, married Alberada, daughter of Henry, Lord Biseth.
 7. Isabel d'Albini died 1301, married Robert de Roos, died 1285, son of Lucia FitzPiers and William de Roos, died 1258, son of Robert de Roos, Magna Carta Surety, (1177-1226), 4th Baron Hamlake, and Isabel, daughter of William (1143-4 Dec. 1214), King of Scotland, son of Henry, Earl Huntingdon, died 12, 1152, son of St. David (1080-May 24, 1153) and Ada de Warrenne who had 16 lines of descent from Charlemagne.

 12. Robert Montague of Sutton Montague married Mary of Devon.
 13. John Montague of Sutton Montague married Agnes More.
 14. William Montague of Sutton Montague married Mary Sutton.
 15. William Montague of Slowe, County Somerset, married Eleanor Peverell of County Devon.
 16. Eleanor Montague married John Bevin.
 17. Katherine Bevin married Alexander Muttleberrie of Jordans, County Somerset, son of Thomas and Joan (Roper) of Muttleberrie.

18. Alice Muttleberrie married John Smith of Holditch, County Dorset, died 1560.
19. Sir George Smith, Knight of Exeter, died 1619, married (1) Joan daughter of James Walker of Exeter, descendant of Mathewes, Herberts and Flewillins of Wales.
20. Sir Nicholas Smith, Knight of Larkbeare, died Nov. 10, 1622, married Dorothea, died 1655, daughter of Sir Ralph Horsey, Knight of County Dorset.
