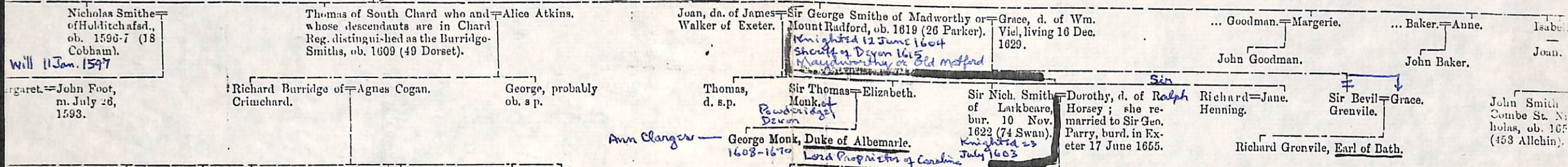
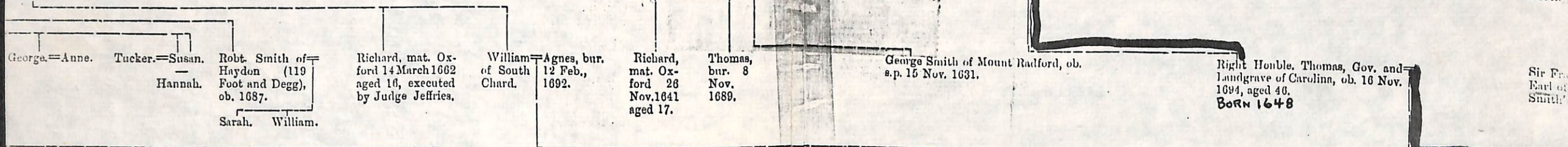

A pencilled note in the volume, "Some Account of the Smiths of Exeter" reads:

"John Smith, (son of Sir Nicholas of Lantkebrass) born 1611 in Exeter, served in the Low Countries, went to South Carolina, purchased land, was a Cassique of South Carolina. There were two sons: Thomas and Paul born both in Exeter and in the same year 1648."
