Dear Cousins,

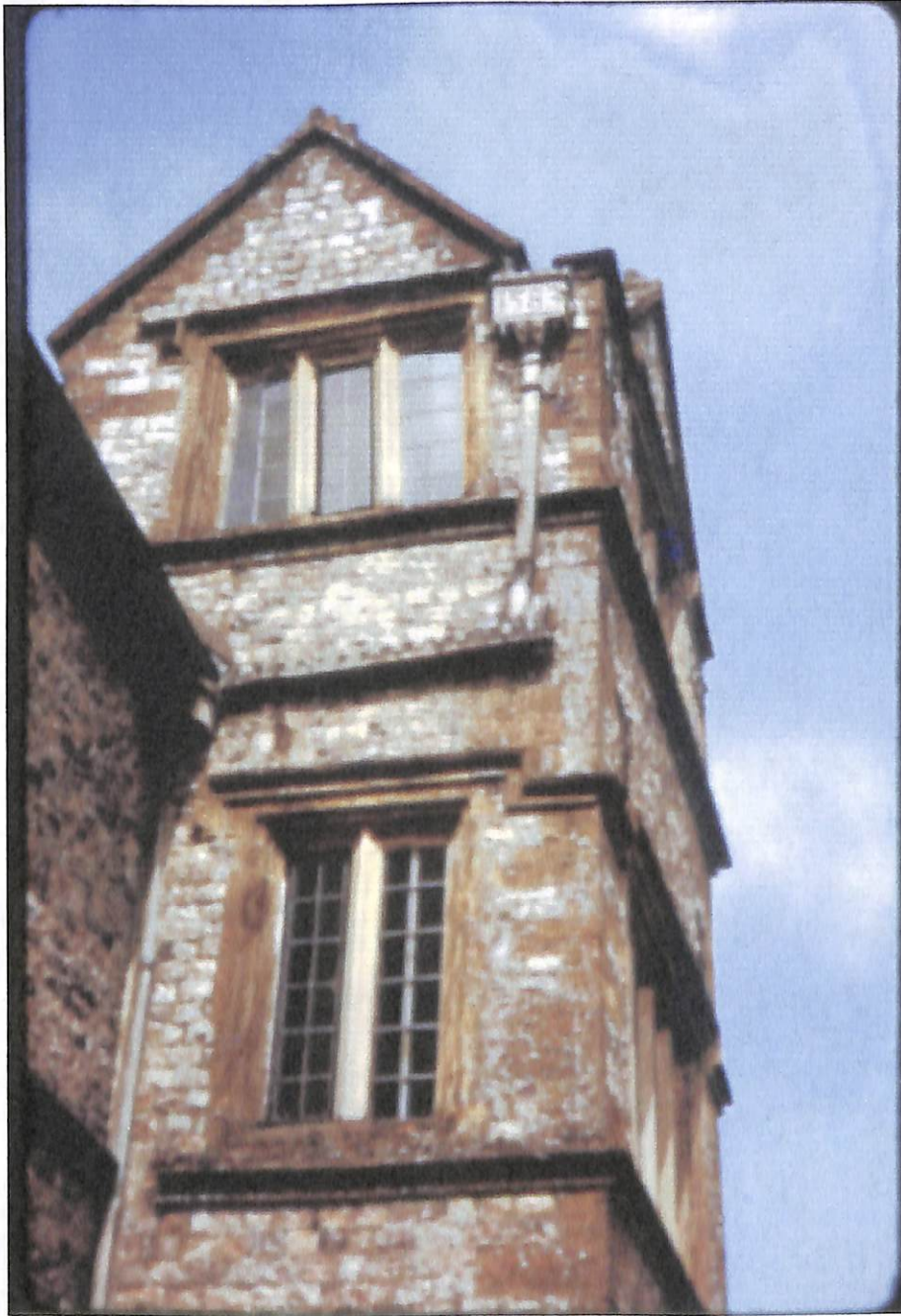
