And first and principally I recommend my Soul  
to God that gave it firmly hoping that by the Mer-  
its & mediation of Jesus Christ my beloved Re-  
deemer I shall obtain the forgiveness of my  
manifold sins & an Inheritance with the Saints  
in Light. My Body I commit to the earth & as  
Such as divine providence do bestow on me I  
give & dispose of them in manner following  
:ving first I will that all my just debts and  
funeral charges ..... off and discharged soon  
after my decease. Item: I give & bequeath unto  
my Son James Maquett my house and land  
upon Edisto Island Item: I give & bequeath my  
son James Maquett Daughter Mary 150 pounds  
to be put out upon Interest: until she comes in  
age or be married. Item: I give & bequeath unto  
the Scotch presbyterian meeting in Charles Town  
..... hundred pounds currency to be put out upon

Interest for the Support of... Ditto Meeting  
Item: I give & bequeath Item: I give & bequeath  
unto John Stanyarne daughter Jane fifty  
pounds currency Item: I give & bequeath the  
freedom of an Indian woman named Sabina  
giving 5 shillings currency to my Son James  
Maguett yearly. Item: I give & bequeath unto my  
Daughter Mary Martini and her heirs a tom  
Lott with dwelling House out houses.... that are  
upon it the Number of Ditto lot is No 125.  
Item: I give & bequeath unto my daughter  
Mary Martini and her heirs all my Bonds, Cash  
... Chattell household goods and all that is men-  
tioned in a deed that I have made the Seventh  
day of February in the thirteenth year of the  
reign of Our Sovereign Lord George the Second  
King of England and in the year of Our Lord  
1743.... forty.... Declare this to be my last will &  
Testament in testimony whereof I have hereto  
set my hand & seal the 21 February 1743  
And I now constitute & appoint John & Mary  
Martini my Executor & Executrix of this my  
last will & testament.

and declared by testator Mary Stewart (S)
