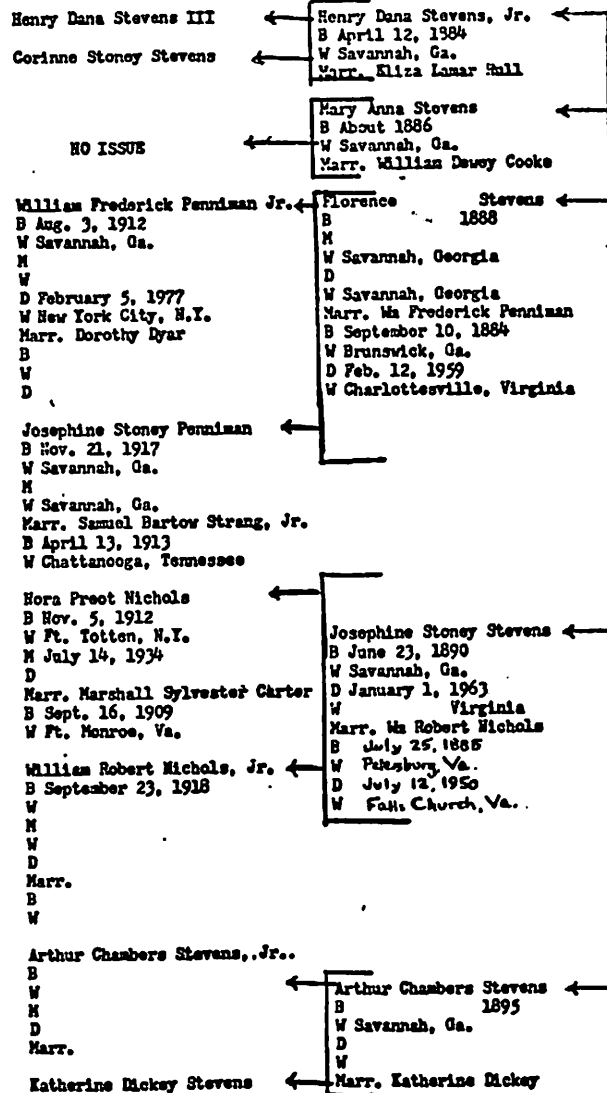
General Micah Jenkins killed in Battle 82 years ago.

"May 6 - the Citadel is mourning her heroes, who gave their lives upon the Battle fields. It looks back & reveres the name of one of its great soldiers - Brig. Gen. Micah Jenkins, C.S.A.

Micah Jenkins was born on Edisto island, Dec. 1, 1835, entered the South Carolina Military Academy in 1851, was graduated as first honor man of the class of 1854. With his classmate, Asbury Coward, he founded the Kings Mountain Military School at Yorkville which he administered with distinction.
