




Daniel Townsend II was probably born in Cha Province of South Carolina, the eldest son of Daniel probably his first wife whose name and date of death married Susannah Winborn (1742 - 1780) about the had five children. She was the daughter of Thomas V malaw Island and his last wife, Susannah Harrison V hy-of VirginiaCarrière (1763-295cp 1780) widew of John Stone,

Daniel and Susannah owned lands on Edisto Islands, but it is not certain on which of these island was no doubt a planter since he owned farm lands ε mately fifty slaves to work them. Both Daniel an buried in a private graveyard on Oak Grove Plantatio Island.

Daniel Townsend died November 18, 1784. Hi two years before described him as being from Wadr weak and sick gentleman, at an advanced age." He l son, Daniel III, land on Edisto Island and nine nega Thomas, he left ten negroes; to his son, John, land Island and twelve negroes; to his two daughters, Al eight negroes each. He left all of his moveable estate when they reached the age of twenty-one and grant they became eighteen or married. He made all three of tors of his Will.

Will of Daniel Townsend b, 17-6-1757, d. 21-5-1842

Daniel Townsend of Edisto Isl'd in Parish of St. Johns Collegton.

1. To my beloved wife Hephzebah Townsend during her life my house and lot in Cannonborough purchased by me from Hrs Eliza Ferguson, After her doath, the same to my children. Also to my wife 20 slaves, also 50 cores of land adjoining John La Roche for slaves to cultivate. Also to my wife one eighth share of cattle, sheep and hogs.

2. To my son John Townsend, the tract of land on which I b.23-10-1799 now reside known as "<u>Eleak Hall</u>" & Porky Island and 19 d,3-2-1881 slaves also one eight part of stock.

3. To my son Daniel Jenkins Townsond, the tract of land which he now resides on known as " Shoregools" plus 20 slaves and one eight stock.

4. To my daughter <u>Tary Frameton Pope</u>one eight of stock also one fifth part of my land on <u>Vadmalaw Island</u> 18 slaves.

5. To my daughter <u>Jucan Martha Townsend</u>, 20 slaves, one fifth part of tract of land on <u>Madmalaw</u>, and one eight of stock.

6. To my daughter <u>A arinthia Jenkins Townsend</u> 19 slaves and one fifth part of <u>Wadmalaw land</u>.

7. To my son Benjamin Joseph Townsend, 19 slaves and one fifth of <u>Madmalaw Land</u>.

8. To my daughter <u>Theodora Elizabeth Townsend</u> 18 slaves and one fifth part of <u>Wadmalaw land</u>.

9. I also give to my children <u>Susan II. Amatinthia J.</u>, <u>Theodora E.</u>, and <u>Deni. J Townsend</u> my lots of land situated within village called <u>Rockville</u>.(Wadmalaw Tsland jsacross N.Edisto River from Edisto, "Bleak Hall") Executors --- Jons John Townsend, Benj. J. Townsend and Daniel Jenkins Townsend. Will drawn March 7, 1833 Proved June 2, 1842

A codical of 1839-----Fearing that his wife may prefer to live at "Sharegrave" instead of house in Charleston, give it to herif she wants it and make other arrangements for Son Daniel Jenkins.
