I am trying to find the parents of William Wiggins, b. North Carolina circa 1806. married Elizabeth ? b. S.C. This family was found in Fayette Co. Georgia in 1850 and Randolph Co. Alabama in 1860 - 1870<sup>and</sup> 1880.

The 1880 census lists his parents as being born in North Carolina.
