

Born about 1750 ----- COLONEL LEVY YOMANS (also spelled Levi)

Col. Levy Youmans was born in England. He was a member of the Tory

Political Party in Great Britian favoring conservation of the existing order of things in state and church and more recently known as the "Conservative Party". He was ~~in~~ a Colonel in the English Army and came to the U.S.A. in 1776 and fought in the Amer. Rev. War. After the Revolution ended, Oct. 19, 1781, Levy went to Bermuda. He did not return to this Country.

We suppose the land he had near Hampton, S.C. in the Black Creek Community was a land grant, (or free-hold) as was the custom in England. This land grant always went to the oldest son.

Levy had two sons, - John was a minister, but Wm. Sr. must have been the oldest son and lived in the Black Creek Community. William Sr. was born in 1777. He and his wife, Mary (Peeples) Youmans are buried in the Old Black Creek Baptist Church Cemetary.

Levy is said to be kinsman of Governor Yeamans, (Sir John) of S.C.

There was a Capt. Levi Youmans (Royalist. of S.C.) in the Siege of Savannah.
