

## A. R. ALLISTON

Appointment:  
National Freedmen's Relief Association (NFRA)  
Hilton Head Island, SC  
November, 1863

A. R. Alliston was appointed by the National Freedmen's Relief Association (NFRA) in November 1863 as a teacher to the freedmen on Hilton Head Island<sup>1</sup>. By May 14, 1869, A. R. was back in Cincinnati, Ohio where she was a Sunday school teacher at the Plum Street Baptist Church, which was founded on July 31, 1867<sup>2</sup>.

No further information is available about this teacher.
