I look forward to hearing your comments and publishing the information you have accumulated through your years of diligent research.

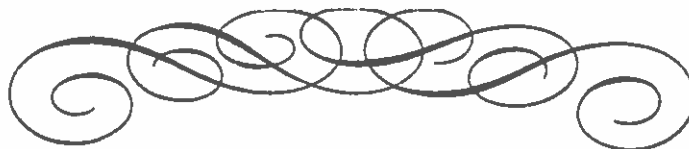

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A marriage often occurred a few days after the license was obtained. Marriages were solemnized by the minister in the church or elsewhere either with a legal license or after banns had been published in the church on 3 different occasions.

Most of the LAYMAN-LEHMAN marriages that have been recorded in Frederick County occurred in the Evangelical Lutheran, Reformed (German Reformed) Lutheran or Lutheran churches. In many instances the records have been duplicated or partially duplicated in several church records.

In Frederick County, Maryland, the practice was to conduct in the same church building the Evangelical (or Reformed) services on alternate Sundays with the standard Lutheran service. This probably accounts for the duplication of records.

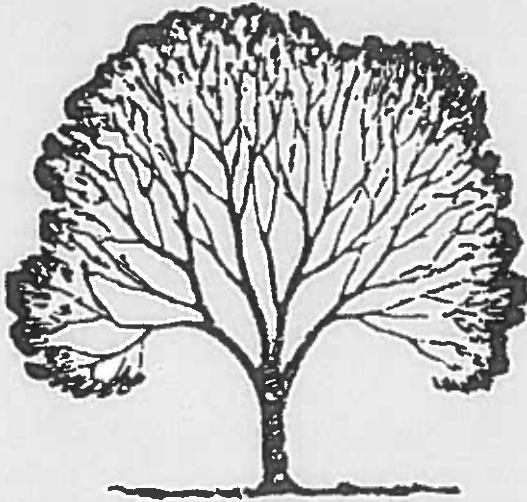
