## P R E F A C E

Volume III of Layman-Lehman Records And Lines is finished and hopefully it will shed some light on your ancestry.

It is rewarding to see the response to our continuing series and I do thank all who have contributed. Many letters of encouragement have been sent to me about this publication. I appreciate hearing from all of you and wish it were possible to have the time to answer all of the letters. So I shall take this way now, to say "THANK YOU" for all your kind words.

If your branch has already been published and you find that it connects with another branch, please advise me so that the new information can be announced. On page 42 is an article about the series and an explanation of the procedure for publishing branches.

We need Bible records, old letters and diaries for our booklet. They can add so much to our family records. Please, only send me copies of your material. I believe it is important to print this type of information so that it will be saved for others to "Look On" later. Several libraries receive the booklets. The latest ones on the list are The Library of Congress and the New England Historic Genealogical Society Library.

I would like to have a Book Review section in the next issues. The books would be Layman-Lehman related. If you know of anyone who has written such a book, I would appreciate knowing their name, address and their book title so that I may contact them.

Are you having difficulty determining which member of the Layman-Lehman family is your "correct" ancestor? Using land records is one way to help sort them out. Consult the Grantee (purchaser) and the Grantor (seller) Deed Indices to locate the deeds and then read all of them for your name. Whenever I find 'et al' on a deed index, I immediately read the deed. Many times it means that the land was an inheritance.

Counties changed throughout the years, reforming to make new counties, until the states became what they are today. The Handy Book For Genealogists by Everton is a good reference to determine which county you should search for records according to your time period. Pennsylvania is a good example of boundary changes. On page 3, in Marriages Found in York County Wills, several towns or townships are named. Adams was formed 1800 from York county; York was formed in 1749 from Lancaster county; Lancaster was formed 1729 from the original county of Chester which was created in 1682.

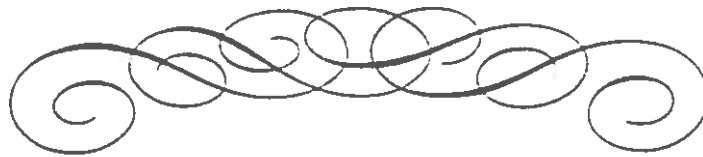

The Rev. MARION FRANKLIN LAYMAN, 67 years old, a retired minister and resident of Carthage for nine years, died at 8 o'clock last night at his home, 2114 West Second street. He had been ill for two years and had been bedfast for two weeks, suffering a complication of ailments.

The Rev. Mr. Layman, who held several pastorates in Kansas, came to Carthage from Carl Junction after his retirement from the ministry. He was born October 12, 1872 at Effingham, Ill, and married November 30, 1899 at Bentonville, ARK to Miss Laura Mason who survives him.

Also surviving are four sons, William Marino and Harold F. Layman, both of Brookfield, ILL, Howard Layman of Carthage and Ray Layman of San Pedro, Calif.; two daughters, Misses Anna Layman of Chicago and Doris Layman of Carthage; a sister Mrs. Clara Sears of Stockton, Calif., children. [typesetter's error] and a brother, Clarence Layman of Washington state, and eight grand-[sic].

Funeral services will be held at the Ulmer funeral home. Burial will be in Oak Hill cemetery. Other funeral plans are incomplete.

"In the name of the Benevolent Father of all, I Eliza Layman of Johnson County and State of Indiana being of sound mind and memory, do hereby make and publish this my last will and testament:

Item 1. It is my will that after my death, my executor shall out of the first moneys that shall come into his hands pay all my just debts, funeral expenses and expenses of last sickness.

Item 2. I do give and bequeath to daughter DELILAH CORE and grand daughter JANE BRYANT the sum of one dollar each and no more.

Item 3. I do give, devise and bequeath to my sons JACOB LAYMAN, JOHN LAYMAN, and FIELDON LAYMAN and my son in law WILLIAM H. MASSEY, all the rest and residue of my estate both personal and real, of which I am seized or have any interest in at the time of my death being all of my estate after paying the debts and expenses in Item 1. And legacies in Item 2 hereof. Each of said sons and said son in law to take one fourth interest in the property herein given them.

Item 4. I do hereby nominate my son Fieldon Layman as executor of this my last will and testament. And I do hereby revoke all former wills by me made.

In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 8th day of September 1887. [Signed with the letter X]

Son JACOB LAYMAN is to pay his sister, SUSANNAH, 50 lbs. specie on 23rd November 1788. He is also to pay his sister, CLARA, 50 lbs. specie on 23rd November 1789.

"Moreover all my moveable goods is to be sold upon a public vendue & my daughter CLARA shall have 20 pounds specie exhernery [?] out of that vendue money, but the rest of the money is to be divided in 4 equal parts.

And therefore I, PHILIP JACOB LAYMAN, have chosen my son in law PHILIP PRICE to be Executor of my estate ....."

# EMIGRATION — MIGRATION



## FROM SWITZERLAND TO GERMANY

The Kraichgau, a region in the eastern part of the Kurpfalz (Palatinate), Germany, lost more than half its population during the Thirty Years War (1618-1649). Switzerland had a surplus in its population during this period.

As most of the people in both areas belonged to the Reformed church, this was an encouragement to the Swiss to emigrate into the Palatinate. The church registers of the Palatinate villages on both sides of the Rhine, from the end of the Thirty Years war until the first decades of the 18th century, reflect this migration. Estimation of the proportion of Swiss in the Kraichgau population has been made to have been about 40 percent.

In 1945 to 1947 Friedrich Zumbach visited over 200 parishes collecting all the entries concerning these Swiss emigrants. This collection was supplemented by the works of German and Swiss genealogists for publication.

It was not possible to identify all places and family names and the church registers did not necessarily record all immigrants. The entries in the publication are written in German with certain codes as to sources.

Your editor has translated some of the German words. Whenever I knew a change of name for a German village, I put it in brackets. My questions regarding an item are also bracketed. The dates were recorded with periods, e.g. 21.6.1706. The 2nd number would be the month. After considerable thought, this editor will not substitute the written month. More research is needed to determine which calendar was used in Germany at that time, the Julian or the Gregorian calendar. In the book each entry is numbered and in numerical order; that number follows each entry here.

If no source record is given, the information is from a church register.

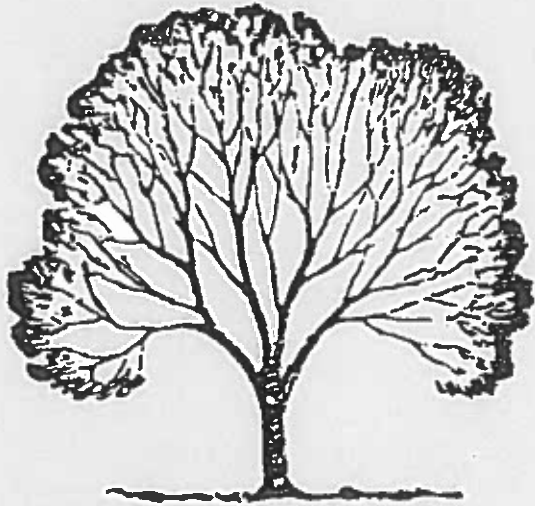

\* I HANS LEHMAN, a native of Schaffhausen, Switzerland, immigrated to America in 1737 with his wife and several children. They arrived at Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, on Oct 8, 1737, aboard the ship Charming Nancy, from Rotterdam, Holland. They settled on a 165-acre farm near Elstonville in Rapho Township, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania. Here Hans and his wife, whose name we do not know, raised a family of ten children. They were Mennonites, Hans died in 1771.

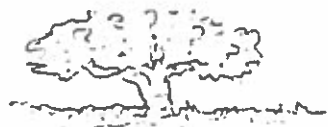
