Dear Miss Redden:

I have searched the Probate Judge's Office for your Mansells. There seems to be nothing there.

I have been working in the Clerk of Court's office and found this:

Deeds M, page 89 Know all men by these presents, that I  
Robert Mansil (sic) of Culpepper County and State of Va.  
a planter --- in fee --- all that parcel, plantation or tract of  
land containing 300 A. situated on Broad River at the mouth of  
Terrible in Fairfield Co., and state of S. C. --- being now in  
the possession of Richard Mansil --- appoint Richard Mansil of  
Fairfield Co. and State of S. C., my true and lawful attorney.

11th February 1797

Recorded 10th July 1799

June 7, 1803. Also 1800 a John Mansell conveyee to Robert Mansel, N Release, P. 75.  
His grave, family cemetery (Samuel Mobley) cemetery at Feasterville.
