Voluntarily list & Enroll our selves in a Volunteer Co. of
Horse to be Commanded by Capt Mathew Singleton I shan
Moore John Singleton in the Parrish of St. Marks subject
to the Resolves of the General Provincial Congress & the
Counsell of Safety for the service of the Colonies purely to
Acct. within the Colony & to be ready upon any & every
Emergency when thereunto Called by the Counsell of Safety
and do hereby bind our selves in a band by all the Ties of re-
ligion & honour to be firm in our duty to our Officers and
Agree willingly and unanimously to be subject to the Acct. for
Mutiny & desertion as other Companies in like circumstances
are so far to be tried by our own Officers of Regiment & Com-
panies to which we belong In witness whereof we have hereunto set
our hands this 26th day of Aug. 1775.
