

Exor Em Jones

vs

H. G. Almy & others

Report of the Registrar
May Term 1825

The Registrar in obedience to a Rule made at the last Term of the Court in the case of John Armstrong Executor against Henrietta G. Almy & others Reports that there is in the hands of the Executor and complainant John Armstrong 1820 - equal to \$3644.43 and the bond of Jacob Waldburger for 1300 - shg which is yet outstanding and unpaid. That it appears from the testimony taken in the case that Henry Bourquin the elder intermarried with a Mrs. Shotling a widow who at the time of such intermarriage had a daughter living Miss Shotling. That Benedict Bourquin the elder a brother of the said Henry Bourquin the elder intermarried with the said Miss Shotling. The two brothers Henry and Benedict Bourquin marrying the Mother and her daughter, the former the Mother and the latter the daughter. That Henry Bourquin the elder died leaving issue by the said Mrs. Shotling five daughters one of whom intermarried with a Mr. Jno. Fox, a second with a Mr. John Morel, a third with a Mr. Huguenin, a fourth with a Mr. Knox afterwards with a Mr. Keall & then with a Mr. Waldburgh, and the fifth with William Jones the complainant & testator. That the testator W. Jones died sometime between the month of September 1798 and June 1799 having survived his said wife & her several sisters. The persons claiming a distributive share of the legacy devised by W. Jones are 1st Mrs. H. G. Almy 2 John H. Morel, William Morel, Harriette Morel and James S. Morel the children and Ann Morel the Widow of Peter H. Morel deceased. 3 John Morel, Thomas N. Morel and Nathaniel G. Rutherford and Ann Rutherford his wife formerly Ann Morel the children of John Morel the younger, deceased. 4 Mary Lloyd a daughter of John Morel the elder. 5 Anthony Barclay and Ann his wife a daughter of Bartholomew Waldburgher. 6 Henry McNish and the children of his sister Mary Catherine Scott deceased formerly W. C. McNish. 7 Sarah Huguenin widow of W. Huguenin, Mary Kelly, widow, formerly Mary Huguenin the children of D. Huguenin who died in 1801. 8 Mrs. Allen and others the grand children of Mrs. Mary Ann McKnight who died in 1805. 9 David F. Bourquin a son of Benedict Bourquin the elder.

1. Henrietta G. Almy. It appears from the evidence taken that Henrietta G. Almy one of the claimants is the daughter of Mrs. Waldburgher one of the sisters of the whole blood of Henrietta B. Jones by Henry Bourquin the elder, and his wife, formerly Mrs. Shotling.
2. Ann Morel the widow of John H. Morel, William Morel, Harriet Morel and James S. Morel, children of Peter Henry Morel. It appears from the evidence that Peter H. Morel was a son of Mrs. Morel another of the sisters of the whole blood of Henrietta B. Jones by Henry Bourquin the elder and his wife formerly Mrs. Shotling.
3. John Morel, Thos N. Morel, N. G. Rutherford and Ann his wife children of John Morel the younger. It appears also by the evidence that Jno Morel the younger was a brother of the whole blood of the above named Peter H. Morel and stood in the same relation to Henrietta B. Jones
4. Mary Lloyd. It appears also by the evidence that Mary Lloyd formerly

Mary Morel is a sister of the whole blood of the above named John Morel and Peter H. Morel and stands in the same relation to H. B. Jones that they did.

5. Anthony Barclay and Ann his wife. It appears also from this evidence that Ann Barclay formerly Ann Waddburgher is the daughter of Bartholomew Waldburgher a brother of the whole blood of the above named H. G. Almy and a nephew of H. B. Jones. that the said Bart. Waldburgher died sometime after the Testator Wm Jones.

6. Henry McNish & the children of his sister Mary Catharine Scott, deceased. It appears by the evidence that Mrs. Waldburgher one of the sisters of Henrietta B. Jones by Henry Bourquin and Mrs. Shotling was married to Keall previous to her intermarriage with Waldburgher, and had children by him - The above parties claim to be the children of Mary Catharine McNish formerly Keall a daughter of the said Keall by the sister of the said Henrietta B. Jones and a niece therefore of H. B. Jones - But they furnish no evidence of these later facts.

7. Sarah Huguenin widow of William Huguenin & her children Joseph McLawn & Eliza his wife formerly Eliza Huguenin, Mary Kelly, widow, formerly Mary Huguenin and James D. Huguenin children of D. Huguenin who died in 1801. It appears from the evidence that one of the sisters of the whole blood of H. B. Jones married a Mr. Huguenin by whom she had three children one named David - It further appears that the father of the present claimants was a David Huguenin but there is no evidence that he was the son of Mrs. Huguenin the sister of H. B. Jones and her nephew.

8. Mrs. Allen and others the grand children of Mrs. M.A. McKnight. It appears by the evidence that Benedict Bourquin the elder, the brother of Henry Bourquin the elder and who married Miss Shotling had issue by her several children one of whom was Mary Ann McKnight who it is proved was the grand Mother of the present claimant. Mrs. McKnight on the father's side was therefore the first cousin of Henrietta B. Jones but on the Mother's side she was the niece of the half blood of H. G. Jones. Mrs. Benedict Bourquin, the mother of Mrs. McKnight & H. B. Jones being descendants of the same Mother Mrs. Shotling who intermarried with Henry Bourquin the elder.

9. David F. Bourquin. It appears by the evidence that David F. Bourquin was a son of Benedict Bourquin the elder by Miss Shotling and he stands therefore in the same relation to H. B. Jones that Mary Ann McKnight did. That John H. Morel is the only administrator of Peter H. Morel deceased and as such claims the share of the said Peter H. Morel.

Morel the adminor of Peter H. Morel is entitled to one share - that Mrs. Henrietta G. Almy is entitled to one share - that Anthony Barclay in right of his wife Ann Barclay is entitled to one share - that the legal Representatives of David F. Bourquin are entitled to one share - that the legal Representative of Mary Ann McKnight are entitled to one share - that the parties claiming under David Huguenin have not made out their claim by sufficient proof to satisfy the Registrar of their right nor have those claiming to be entitled under Mary Catharine McNish made out their claim satisfactorily.
