## Heraldic Description of Armorial Bearings.



CAMPBELL OF LOCHOW. DUKE OF ARGYLL

Arms: Quarterly. 1 and 4, Gyrony of eight, or and sable, for the name of Campbell, 2 and 3. are for the Lordship of Lorn-viz., Argent, a galley, sails furled sable, flag and pennons gules. Behind the shield are placed: in bend dexter, A baton gules, semé of thistles or, ensigned with an imperial crown proper, and thereon the crest of Scotland, borne as hereditary Master of the Royal Household; in bend sinister, A sword proper, hilt and pommel or, indicative of the office of Lord Justice General. Supporters: Two lions guardant gules. Crest: A boar's head couped or. Mottoes: above the shield, "Ne obliviscaris" (Forget not), and, below the shield. "Vix ea nostro voco' (I scarcely call all this my own).

CAMPBRILL OF GLENORCHY. EARL OF BREADALBANE

Arms: Quarterly, 1 and 4, Gyrony of eight, or and sable, for Campbell, 2, Argent, a lymphad, sails furled sable, for the Lordship of Lorn. 3, Or, a fess chequy azure and argent, for Stewart. Crest: A boar's head erased proper. Supporters: Two stags proper, attired and unguled or. Motto: "Follow me."

Arms: Quarterly. 1. Or, a hart's head cabossed sable, attired gules, for the name of Calder. 2, Gyrony of eight, or and sable, for Campbell. 3, Argent, a galley with her oars in action sable, for Lorn. 4, Per fess azure and gules a cross or, for Lort of Stack pole. Crest: A swan proper crowned or. Supporters: Dexter, A lion rampant guardant gules, armed or; Sinister, A hart proper. Motto: " Be mindful."

## Heraldic Description of Armorial Bearings.

Arms: Gyrony of eight, ermine and gules (being Campbell differenced by change of tinctures), to show relation to the Crawfurds of Loudoun. Crest: An eagle displayed with two heads within a flame of fire. Supporters: On the dexter side, or, chevalier in armour holding a pike proper; on the sinister, a lady nobly dressed and holding in her left hand a missive. Motto: " I byde my tyme."

Arms: Quarterly. 1, Or, a lion rampant gules. 2, Arg, a hand couped fessways, holding a heart in pale gules, a label of three points azure charged with as many bulls' heads cabossed of the first. 3. Az, a boar's head erased or, armed proper and langued gules. 4, Or, a lymphad sails furled and oars in saltire azure. Over all an inescutcheon or charged with a lymphad sails furled and oars in saltire azure, flagged gules, as chief of Clan Chattan. Crest: A wild cat salient proper. Supporters: Two wild cats proper. Motto over: "Touch not the catt but a glove."

Arms: Gules, a boar's head couped or. Crest: A dexter hand with dagger and boar's head transfixed. Supporters: Two savages wreathed about the loins, bearing oak staves leaved proper resting on the ground. Mottoes: underneath escutcheon. "Vi aut Virtute" (By virtue or valour) and, above escutcheon, "Feros ferio" (To the rough I am rough).

Arms: Argent, a saltire engrailed sable. Crest: A hart's head couped gules attired argent. Supporters: Two ratch hounds argent, collared sable. Motto: "Si je puis" (If I can).
