✓ John Milam, dec., Inventory of estate, November 1780.

Will of Thomas Milam probated March 1775; wife, Mary; children, Solomon and Rush. May have been other children.

From "Bedford Co., Va., Index of Wills, 1754-1830", edited by Rowland D. Buford, late Clerk of Bedford Co., Va., 1917:

" , Sally, 24 November 1828.
