James Leak Sr. died in Pike Co. Ga. 1839
after fathering between 16 - 18 children by
his 2 wives. He is my husband's gr, gr,
gr. granddad by his first marriage.
James & Martha Neal Leak Jr. is my husband's
gr, gr granddad. Several of his descendants
migrated to Marshall Co & Cullman Co. Ala.
in 1881-89.
